Dr. Artee Young is the Executive Director of The Evergreen State College-Tacoma Campus. Prior to serving as Director, she was on the faculty for over 20 years and also served as Chair of the faculty – which includes the Olympia Campus, the Tacoma Campus and the five Reservation Based Programs. Dr. Young has taught humanities at other institutions of higher learning including the University of Washington (Seattle), Indiana University, The University of Michigan and Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. She has also served as a judicial law clerk for two Washington State Supreme Court Justices.

She has done significant and ongoing work on Title VII issues for a United States governmental agency, and she is a frequent reviewer of grants and proposals for the National Center on Minority Health and Health Disparities, one of the Centers comprising the National Institutes of Health.

Dr. Young earned the B.A., *cum laude*, from Southern University; the M.A. from Eastern Michigan University; the Ph.D. from University of Michigan; and the J.D. from University of Puget Sound School of Law, where she was inducted into Order of the Barristers.

Dr. Young serves on several Boards and committees of local and international organizations. Among them are Citizens for a Healthy Bay, United Way of Pierce County, several advisory committees for Group Health Cooperative including the Pierce County Leadership Advisory Group, and the Western Institutional Review Board, an international company specializing in human subject protection.

She is a member of the National Bar Association, the Washington State Bar Association and the Pierce County Bar Association.

Dr. Young is a nationally recognized academician and change agent who demonstrates passionate commitment to systemic betterment and the positive transformation of lives.
