Human Resources Director Report and Requests:

Mary McDougal, Human Resources Manager on behalf of Human Resources Director, Joy St. Germain advised the Board that she had a Request for Non-Competitive Appointments for two individuals. She then introduced Human Resources Analyst, Bob Paz to present the requests. Mr. Paz provided the Board with a brief explanation of the request to permanently appoint ChiQuata Elder and Colin DeForest to the position of Program Development Specialist, 2322. He then introduced Neighborhood and Community Services Director, Tansy Hayward to answer any questions the Board might have.
