A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 5 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED AS WRITTEN.

Human Resources Director Report / Requests:

BOARD MEMBER SEXTON MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE NON COMPETITIVE APPOINTMENT OF KRISTY BROKMAN TO LEAD GRAPHIC ARTS SPECIALIST. BOARD MEMBER KIELIAN SECONDED THE MOTION.

A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 5 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. The non-competitive appointments are approved.

Jeff Geforos and Jim Nunn to the classification of Recovery & Transfer Center Supervisor.

BOARD MEMBER SEXTON MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE NON COMPETITIVE APPOINTMENT OF KRISTY BROKMAN TO LEAD GRAPHIC ARTS SPECIALIST. BOARD MEMBER KIELIAN SECONDED THE MOTION.

A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 5 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. The non-competitive appointments are approved.

Comments by the public: None

Comments by Board Members:

BOARD MEMBER HANSEN BEGAN BY SUGGESTING THAT THE BOARD CONSIDER ADDING LONG TERM PLANNING TO A FUTURE STUDY SESSION, IN ORDER TO PLAN FOR FUTURE ITEMS THE BOARD MAY WISH TO CONSIDER AND/OR ADDRESS. CHAIR SUMMERS AGREED THAT LONG TERM PLANNING WOULD BE A GOOD TOPIC FOR A STUDY SESSION. A QUESTION FROM BOARD MEMBER HELLER ASKED IF THIS WAS AN APPROPRIATE TOPIC FOR A STUDY SESSION, AND LEGAL COUNSEL CONFIRMED THAT IT COULD BE AN APPROPRIATE TOPIC, AND ALSO RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD LIMIT THE SUBJECTS OF A STUDY SESSION TO ONE OR TWO ITEMS. BOARD MEMBER KIELIAN AGREED WITH COUNSEL.

CHAIR SUMMERS RECOMMENDED THAT BOARD MEMBERS COMMUNICATE DIRECTLY WITH THE BOARD COORDINATOR, WITH ANY POSSIBLE TOPICS FOR CONSIDERATION AT A STUDY SESSION. SHE WILL COMPILE, AND THE BOARD CAN THEN PRIORITIZE THE ITEMS FOR FUTURE STUDY SESSIONS.

CHAIR SUMMERS PROVIDED AN UPDATE REAGARDING A CONVERSATION WITH CITY MANAGER BROADNAX ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF BROADCASTING CIVIL SERVICE BOARD MEETINGS ON TV TACOMA. THE CITY MANAGER INDICATED THAT THERE ARE NO PLANS TO BROADCAST CIVIL SERVICE BOARD MEETINGS ON TV TACOMA. THERE WAS SOME DISCUSSION OF OTHER WAYS THIS MIGHT BE HANDLED (I.E. YOUTUBE). BOARD MEMBER SEXTON THAT THERE WOULD BE A BENEFIT TO THE COMMUNITY TO BE ON-AIR, AND THAT ANY MEDIA WOULD BE BETTER THAN NOTHING. HE IS CONCERNED THAT THE BOARD BE ACCESSIBLE.

CHAIR SUMMERS ALSO ADDRESSED THE CHANGE IN BUILDING SECURITY FOR THE TACOMA MUNICIPAL BUILDING. THERE IS SOME CONSIDERATION BEING GIVEN TO PROVIDING ACCESS BADGES TO BOARD MEMBERS, INSTEAD OF REQUIRING THAT THEY OBTAIN A VISITOR BADGE FROM BUILDING SECURITY. MORE INFORMATION WILL BE FORTHCOMING.
