## **Call to Order:**

## **Human Resources Director Report / Requests:**

Human Resources Director, Joy St. Germain introduced Human Resources Analyst, Rodney Croston who presented the Request for Waiver of Competitive Exam for Administrative Assistant Julie Stephens. Board Member Heller motioned to approve the request. The motion was seconded by Board Member Sexton.

A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 2 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. THE MOTION TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF JULIE STEPHENS PASSED.

Mr. Croston then presented a Request for Waiver of Competitive Exam for Energy Conservation Coordinator, Sara Bowles. Board Member Heller motioned to approve this request. The motion was seconded by Board Member Sexton.

A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 2 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. THE MOTION TO PERMANENTLY APPOINT SARA BOWLES INTO THE CLASSIFICATION OF ENERGY PROGRAM COORDINATOR PASSED.

Teresa Dent, Human Resources Analyst presented a Request for Waiver of Competitive Exam for Fire Fighter Paramedics Chris Wood and Mandy Jacques. Board Member Heller motioned to approve this request. The motion was seconded by Board Member Sexton.

A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 2 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. THE MOTION TO PLACE CHRIS WOOD AND MANDY JACQUES INTO THE CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE FIGHTER PARAMEDIC PASSED.

Chair Summers asked if all Board Members have reviewed the Director's report and if there were any questions. Hearing none, she moved to the Coordinator's report, followed by consideration of matters set for public hearing and action on matters still pending. Hearing none, the Chair moved to communication for information.

Jennifer Taylor advised the Board that she has reviewed the request for a complaint received from Danielle Roose and shared reasons as to why this request was declined. This matter is not within the Board's scope and jurisdiction.

Board Member Sexton shared that he is not up to speed on this. Chair Summers posed the question on how the Board prefers communication regarding the denial be sent, whether Ms. Hobson sends the letter out as in the past or whether the letter would be drafted by Ms. Hobson and would be signed by the Chair. A VOICE VOTE WAS TAKEN: 2 AYES, 0 NAYS, 0 ABS. THE REQUEST FOR COMPLAINT SUBMITTED BY DANIELLE ROOSE WAS DENIED.

Board Member Sexton motioned to approve the minutes of May 5, 2016. Board Member Heller seconded the motion.
