Plastics must be washed, sterilized, and fully dry.

### PLASTIC

Nets that fruits and vegetables come in  
Small, transparent plastic containers that close/hinge: clear plastic small berry boxes,  
Small vinyl or clear envelopes of any kind  
Caps/lids of any description, from very small to coffee can-sized  
Pump, spray, squirt bottle tops (non toxic cleaning, shampoo, dish soaps)  
Pen caps  
Small plastic doo-hickeys of any kind from packaging  
Twist-ties, wires from packaging, plastic bread closers

### CDs

Plastic bags in interesting colors: translucent and opaque  
Costume Jewelry: especially earrings and beads  
Old Christmas tinsel/garlands

### FABRIC

String, yarn, ribbons  
Buttons with big holes  
Soft, silky, shiny, or metallic fabric scraps (fleece is especially good)  
Clean, Soft pretty socks that do not have mates  
Clean pantyhose or tights

### PAPER

Any papers with unusual/interesting patterns or textures  
Greeting Cards  
Tickets  
Any stickers or self-adhesive labels  
Maps  
Metallic wrapping paper scraps (flat, not crumpled)  
Manila and colored file folders, colored card stock (one side blank)  
Tiny cardboard or plastic boxes (the kind that jewelry comes in)
