7. Presentations

A. Arts Education Research Initiative

5:18 pm (10:41)

Lisa Jaret, Arts Education Program Manager for the Washington State Arts Commission (WSAC), gave an overview of the arts education programs run by WSAC and presented the findings of the Arts Education Research Initiative (AERI) study. Lisa noted that there is a gap between the current education policy and actual practice in the classroom. The AERI study suggests the need for more arts instruction, improved access to approved curricula, accurate assessment of student learning in the arts, support of the arts teaching workforce, creation of a sustainable funding stream, collaboration with community arts partners, and sharing the benefits of arts education.

It was suggested that the Commission could help spread the findings of the study by presenting the AERI brochure to the Tacoma school board. Another idea is to initiate coffee meetings with members of the school board or with Tacoma 360.

8. Action Items

A. Retreat

6:02 pm (54:30)

The 2010 Commission retreat is set for March 20, 10 am - 3 pm at Franke Tobey Jones in the Wellness Center.

Commissioners and staff suggested the following topics for the retreat:

- Look at the notes from the 2009 retreat and to then define goals for 2010
- Develop a Municipal Art Plan to recommend to City Council
- Discuss the funding program guidelines for Anchor Fund and Arts Projects

B. Arts Projects Policy

6:10 pm (1:02:54)

Commissioners discussed concerns about two specific guidelines in the 2009 Arts Projects application. The guidelines of concern state that Arts Projects funding does not support "Organizations whose governance are themselves taxing authorities or organizations whose primary purpose is fundraising for such taxing authorities" and "Projects, programs or special events sponsored by schools or school-based auxiliary organizations (e.g., PTSAs)".

The concern is that these guidelines exclude any schools from applying for funding. Commissioners considered whether these restrictions are still relevant to the needs of our community and the funding program today.

It was suggested that the guidelines require matching funding for schools and to clarify matching fund requirements (i.e.: cash or in kind services) for certain organizations. It was also suggested to pass the guidelines through the legal department to make sure that updating the current guidelines to allow funding for arts projects produced by taxing authorities or schools would not be illegal.

C. Public Art Training and Planning

6:28 pm (1:20:34)

Amy McBride presented a draft of a public art plan outlining public art projects and programs. Current projects include: Welcome Figure, Projecting Drop (for Pacific Plaza), Resonance Chamber (for Center for Urban Waters), installation of portable works collection at TPU, and ongoing maintenance and conservation. Upcoming projects include: Temporary Contemporary Tacoma (downtown temporary art installations), Aerial Gallery (downtown banners), Public Art Training Program, Mural Art Training Program, Stewart Heights Substation, Civil Right Legacy (for People's Pool), Cheney Stadium, Elks on Broadway and adjacent mixed use development, and a portable works purchase.

Commissioners Kelly and Sweney volunteered to sit on the review panel for Temporary Contemporary Tacoma.
