This bright mural has put the Fern Hill district on the map. Reading from left to right, it has the look of a vintage postcard, then slowly pixelates into an abstract design. From start to finish, the 89' 5" x 25' mural took one month of hard work by a team of 3 artists to complete. When the artist team started painting the mural, many local residents were skeptical of the bright blue foundation coat, but after it began to take shape, drivers would honk their horns, give a thumbs-up, and say, "Good job!" to the muralists.

This building used to have peeling gray and forest green paint with fading lettering on the side. Char, part owner of the Foam & Fabric building on which the mural is sited said, "New customers have been able to find our store and the mural has been great for business. It is not only a beautiful mural, but a landmark for Fern Hill."
