    - 1. Commissioner Ladenburg asks if shelters are first-come, first-serve.
      - a. Answer: Combination of "de facto dibs" by those with a bed from the night before/most vulnerable are served first.
    - 2. Chair Wilson inquires abut plans for addressing unexpected weather changes, such as atmospheric river, that does not meet current sever weather criteria.
      - a. Answer: best provided by Department of Emergency Management at other time.
