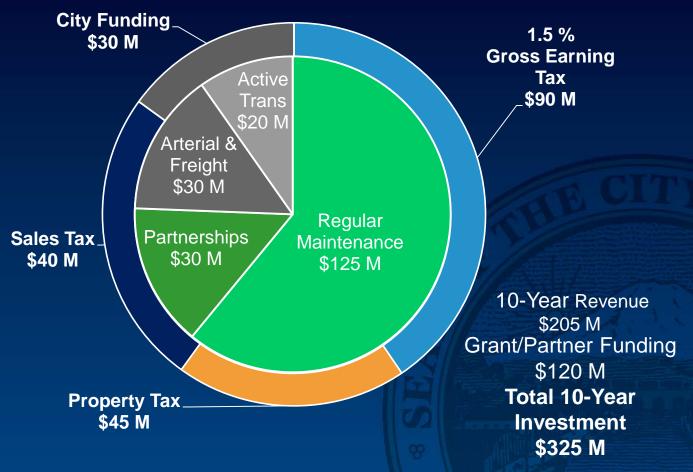

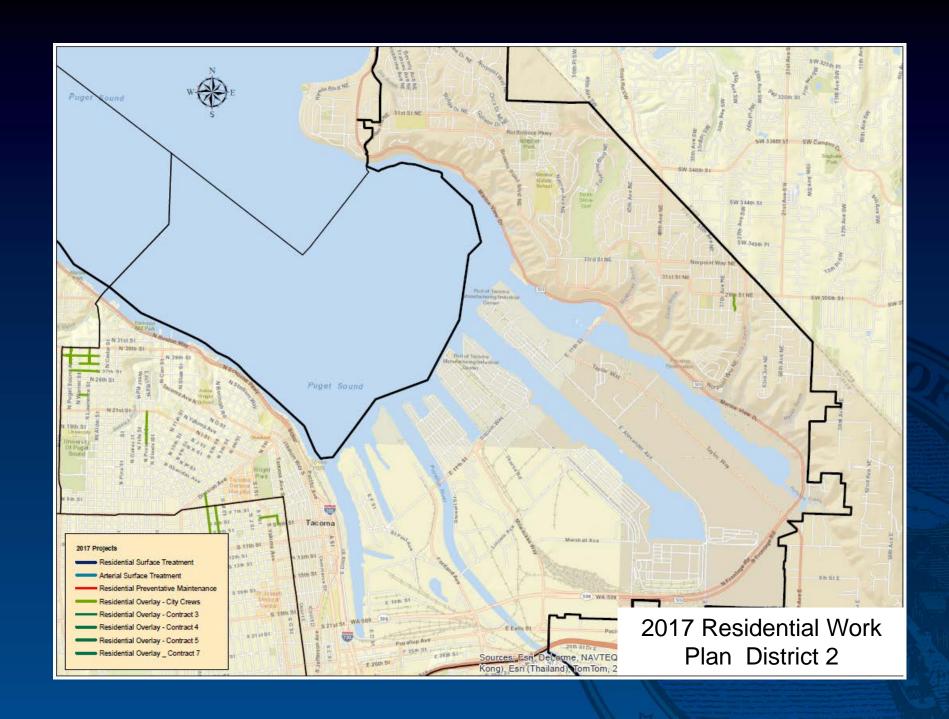
2017 Projected Service Level

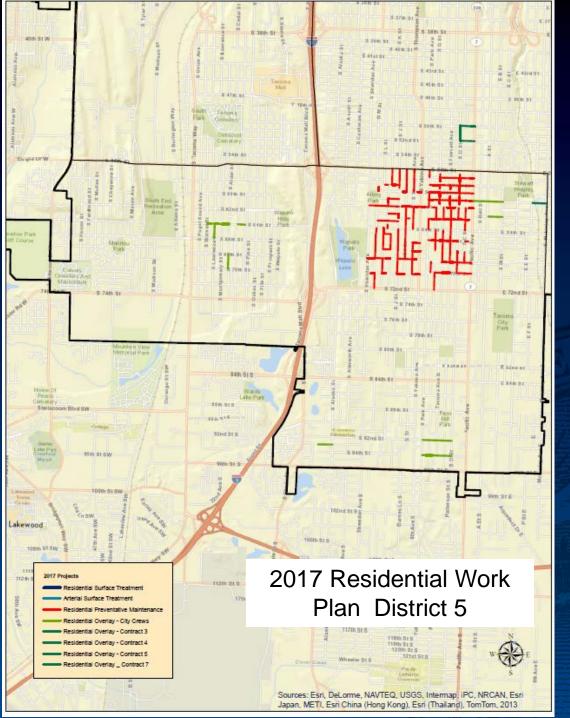
