TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN – TIMELINE UPDATE AND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN COORDINATION (JENNIFER KAMMERZELL), INFORMATIONAL Jennifer Kammerzell presented an updated timeline of the Transportation Master Plan (TMP) adoption, which included agenda topics/deadlines, public outreach, IPS presentations, and coordination with the Comprehensive Plan adoption process. Public outreach will begin March 5th. The Commission is expected to forward a recommended draft to IPS on April 15th. The document will be adopted in conjunction with the Comprehensive Plan in October 2015. CM Hyman asked staff to attend the Downtown Merchant Group meeting on March 5th. CM Thurlow recommended attending the Community Council meeting in February to provide an overview of the public outreach in March. TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN – REVIEW OF GOALS AND POLICIES , ACTION: APPROVAL FOR INCLUSION IN PUBLIC DRAFT (JUSTIN RESNICK AND KENDRA BREILAND) Kendra Breiland and Justin Resnick presented the updated draft Goals and Policies document. Co-Chair Moore facilitated the review working from the last Goal #7 towards Goal #1.
