Question 1: All number 9 locations on Yakima are arterial, is the intent to pay one traffic control for all 9 locations or per location? Same question for 34th St, MLK and the other areas?

Answer 1: After review of the specific work zones, addendum (4) will be issued to add quantities to the temporary traffic control bid items. Additions are at the following locations:

Add one Residential Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 6 –Tacoma Ave Add one Residential Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 9 –Tacoma Ave Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 26 – Yakima Ave Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 29 – Yakima Ave Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 79 – MLK Jr. Way Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 707 – 46th & Yakima Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 795 – 46th & Yakima Add one Arterial Work Zone Temporary Traffic Control at work-site 798 – 46th & Yakima
