### **Call to Order**

At approximately 6:07 pm, Vice Chair Ronald Malm, called meeting to order. Staff liaison, Chantra Real, did roll call.

# **Discussion of Mayor & City Council Salaries**

Vice Chair, began meeting with former council member, David Boe. Richard questioned the work load of a council member and how it interrelates to council salaries. Richard continued to ask, what is the biggest surprise as a council member? Mr. Boe's response was the amount of setbacks and assumptions received from being an appointed councilmember. David advised that his position as councilmember is expected to be a part time work load, however, the amount of work that was put into being a councilmember is more full time. David described roles are precise depending on varying district that may involve unions, constituents, council meetings and how much responsibility was taken. Richard and Dianne inquired on why Tacoma City Council members salary are high comparable to other City's Council Members. Per Boe, the scopes of services and programs that the City of Tacoma provides are huge in comparison to some other cities. Likewise, the budget that is available in certain cities also varies. Similarly, Mayor is out and about whereas City Manager is in house. Mayor is treated as a full time position. Joe inquired on what David's opinion of the salary was. Per David, he was happy to be compensated for being a council member along with benefits of health care and parking. However, depending on work load, sometimes, per hour would go down to about \$12/hour. For Boe, work as councilmember has full time expectations and requires a balance of personal life, current workload as well as current duties as councilmember. (David Boe exited 6:45 pm). Discussion of survey results by commission members followed.
