### **Resolution No. 37899**

Setting Tuesday, November 10, 2009, at approximately 5:30 p.m., as the date for a public hearing by the City Council on the proposed Ad Valorem tax levies.

**Ordinance No. 27839**

Amending Chapter 11.05 of the Municipal Code, relating to parking restrictions, by repealing and reenacting Sections 11.05.240 and 11.05.250, granting the City Manager, or his or her designee, the authority to establish school zones and on-street parking restrictions within the city.

**Amended Substitute Ordinance No. 27840**

Amending Chapter 11.05 of the Municipal Code, relating to the implementation of parking pay stations, by reenacting Section 11.05.260, establishing parking rates for parking pay stations based on market rates; incorporating revenues into the Parking Enterprise Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to manage the parking system with the assistance of a Parking Enforcement Advisory Task Force.

## RESOLUTION NO. 37899

A RESOLUTION relating to revenue sources; setting November 10, 2009, as the date for a public hearing to set the proposed Ad Valorem tax levies and other general fund revenues.

WHEREAS RCW 84.55.120 requires that a taxing district, other than the state, that collects regular levies shall hold a public hearing on revenue sources for the district's following year's current expenses budget, and

WHEREAS the hearing must include consideration of possible increases in property tax revenues and shall be held prior to the time the taxing district levies the taxes or makes the request to have the taxes levied; Now, Therefore,

WHEREAS RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a)(iii) permits amendments to the Comprehensive Plan more frequently than once per year if the amendments are to the Capital Facilities Element and occur concurrently with the adoption or amendment of the City's budget; Now, Therefore,

A RESOLUTION relating to finance; setting Tuesday, November 17, 2009, as the date for a public hearing concerning the proposed issuance of recovery zone facility bonds.

WHEREAS, the City is proposing the issuance of recovery zone facility bonds ("Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$4,979,000, and

WHEREAS the proceeds of the Bonds will be used by the City to finance the rehabilitation, improvement, construction, and expansion of Cheney Stadium, and

WHEREAS a public hearing is required to be scheduled before the City Council prior to the issuance of recovery zone facility bonds, per Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, as part of the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982; Now, Therefore,

## **RESOLUTION NO. 37902**

A RESOLUTION relating to information technology; authorizing the execution of an interlocal agreement with the City of Puyallup to enable updating of the operational relationship between the parties regarding the 800MHz radio communications interoperability network.

WHEREAS the City of Tacoma (“CITY”) and the City of Puyallup (“PUYALLUP”) utilize an 800 MHz public safety radio network, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted by RCW 39.34, on or about September 18, 2007, the CITY and PUYALLUP entered into an Interlocal Agreement (“Agreement”), which Agreement was approved by CITY Resolution No. 37252 and PUYALLUP Resolution No. 2056, in order to form a partnership to support the development of an 800 MHz radio communications interoperability network by utilizing common technical standards, using common radio systems linked with other regional public safety systems, and the use of dispatch centers linked to a common network, and

WHEREAS the parties have determined that it is necessary to replace and supercede the original Agreement with a document that better defines the current operational relationship between the parties, and

WHEREAS the parties shall collaborate with each other pursuant to the proposed agreement to assure successful ongoing operations in order to enable Puyallup to continue utilizing the Tacoma system ID 830D and capabilities of Tacoma’s master site; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the City of Tacoma is approved to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Puyallup to enable updating of the operational relationship between the parties regarding the 800MHz radio communications interoperability network, and that the proper City officers are authorized to execute said agreement, said document to be substantially in the form of the interlocal agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk and as approved by the Office of the City Attorney.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Finance Department recommends a contract be awarded to **PiperJaffray & Co. Seattle, WA**, for bond underwriting services. The bond sales will be closed before December 31, 2009. The contract amount reflects a total award of \$275,000.00, sales tax not applicable.

**EXPLANATION:** The City of Tacoma, Finance Department is requesting an award to an investment banking firm to serve as an underwriter in connection with the proposed issuance of approximately 35 million dollars of 2009 Limited Tax General Obligation Bonds (the "2009 Bonds"). These Bonds are currently planned for sale in November 2009, for certain capital improvements within the City of Tacoma.

**COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION:** Request for Proposals Specification No. F109-0596F was opened September 22, 2009. Twelve companies were invited to bid in addition to normal advertising of the project. Six submittals were received.

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2008, Resolution No. 37624 authorized execution of Amendment No. 1 to the agreement, which was necessary to add negotiations for work relating to the 800 MHz Reconfiguration project, and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2009, the parties entered into Amendment No. 2 to the agreement, increasing the agreement in the amount of \$75,000, for a cumulative total of \$175,000, and

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2009, the parties entered into Amendment No. 3 to the agreement, increasing the agreement in the amount of \$80,000, for a cumulative total of \$255,000, and

WHEREAS the parties now desire to increase the agreement in the amount of \$50,000, for a cumulative total of \$305,000, to ensure that the law firm can continue providing legal representation through the conclusion of these matters; Now, Therefore,

## **RESOLUTION NO. 37905**

A RESOLUTION relating to City-owned property; authorizing the conveyance of 22 City-owned parks and associated City parcels to the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma ("Metro Parks") for the provision of parks and parks facility operations and maintenance services.

WHEREAS, on October 21, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 37626, authorizing the execution of a ten-year interlocal agreement with the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma ("Metro Parks"), providing for the conveyance of certain City-owned parks and facilities and associated parcels, as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," and

WHEREAS the City and Metro Parks agree that it is to their benefit, as well as the benefit of the citizens of the City, to centralize all park facilities, operations, and maintenance of City parks with Metro Parks, and

WHEREAS the centralization of park services will allow the parties to gain efficiencies by reducing overhead and eliminating the duplication of efforts, and

WHEREAS the City and Metro Parks also wish to develop the sustainable funding sources and strategies that will allow Metro Parks to manage all parks and facilities without the necessity of City funding, and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 37713, approving the conveyance of 21 of the 22 parks, and

WHEREAS the process of finalizing the deeds for conveyance raised issues for both the City and Metro Parks, and

WHEREAS, as a result, the City and Metro Parks have negotiated additional terms relating to the specific parcels contemplated in the conveyance, environmental liability, and reversionary interests, and

WHEREAS the parties have prepared two quit claim deeds to accomplish the conveyance of those parks and associated properties listed on the attached Exhibit "A" and now seek final approval from the City Council for this transfer; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the conveyance of 22 City-owned parks and facilities, listed on Exhibit "A," to the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma for the provision of parks and associated City parcels facility operations and maintenance services is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute two quit claim deeds for the conveyance of those parks and associated properties listed on the attached Exhibit "A," said documents to be substantially in the form of the proposed quit claim deeds on file in the office of the City Clerk.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 37906**

A RESOLUTION relating to City-owned property; authorizing the conveyance of Wright Park to the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma.

WHEREAS, in 1886, the Tacoma Land Company dedicated a large tract of land to the City for the purpose of developing a public park, with the condition that the land would be used for no other purpose, and

WHEREAS, between the years of 1891 and 1910, the City, at the request of the parks commissioner, began purchasing land adjacent to the dedicated park area to expand Wright Park, and

WHEREAS, in 1907, Washington State passed a law allowing cities to form separate park districts, and

WHEREAS, after the governor signed the bill, residents voted to establish the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma (“Metro Parks”) as a separate municipal corporation with the ability to collect property taxes for support, and

WHEREAS Metro Parks was incorporated on April 6, 1907, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2894, passed on March 13, 1907, upon passing of the proposition to form Metro Parks as a separate and distinct municipal corporation, title to those certain properties owned by the City and set aside as park properties were to immediately vest in the Board of Park Commissioners; however, requisite conveyance documents were never recorded, and

WHEREAS the parties have prepared a quit claim deed to accomplish the conveyance of Wright Park; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the conveyance of Wright Park to the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma (“Metro Parks”) is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute a quit claim deed for the conveyance of Wright Park to Metro Parks, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed quit claim deed on file in the office of the City Clerk.

**Two-hour parking – Areas designated.**

Within the following area no vehicle shall be parked for a longer period than two hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., except on Sundays and legal holidays: Old City Hall Parking Lot 625 Commerce St.

**Five-hour parking – Zones designated.**

Upon the following streets parking shall be parallel to the curb, and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. no vehicle shall be parked for a longer period than five hours, except on Sundays and legal holidays:

**SUBSTITUTE  
ORDINANCE NO. 27840**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the implementation of parking pay stations; amending Chapter 11.05 of the Tacoma Municipal Code (“TMC”) to reenact Section 11.05.260 TMC, establishing parking rates for parking pay stations based on market rates; incorporating revenues into the Parking Enterprise Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to manage the parking system with the assistance of a Parking Management Advisory Task Force.

WHEREAS the decision to move to paid parking and the management of the parking system is needed to ensure parking turnover, and

WHEREAS, while numerous users need parking in the downtown area, the priority customer in the public supply is the customer/visitor who uses downtown to shop, dine, recreate, and

WHEREAS the purposes and methodologies for moving to paid parking and the management of the parking system were established through dialogue with stakeholders and input from downtown employers, employees, residents, and customers, as well as a study of best practices in peer communities, and

WHEREAS such customers/visitors are key to the downtown area’s future growth and vitality and must be accommodated, and

WHEREAS the move to paid parking and the other provisions embodied herein are designed to (1) make the downtown accessible to all users through multiple travel modes, (2) make downtown parking user-friendly by being easy to access and easy to understand, (3) assure that affected downtown stakeholders are involved in decisions about parking policy, (4) make downtown parking more convenient and accessible for the priority user/customer (5) provide a parking product in the downtown area that is of the highest quality

and safe to create a positive customer experience, (6) recognize on-street parking as a finite resource and assure maximum access for the priority customer, (7) manage the public parking supply by using the 85 percent rule, (8) encourage alternate travel modes, for example, transit, bike, walk, and ride sharing, and (9) continue the advice and input of the affected stakeholders, and

WHEREAS the implementation of pay stations has the support of the City's downtown merchants, residents, property owners, and other parking stakeholders whose work consisted of an assessment of the parking system and a set of recommended changes, and

WHEREAS the recommendations are consistent with the City Center Parking and Mobility Strategy presented at the August 11, 2009, Study Session;  
Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Section 11.05.260 of the Tacoma Municipal Code is reenacted to read as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A."

Section 2. The date of passage hereof notwithstanding, this Ordinance shall become effective on March 31, 2010.

EXHIBIT "A"

**11.05.260 On-street parking regulation. Pay stations; establishing pay station rates, designating revenues; citizen advisory committee.**

The City Manager, or his or her designee, shall have the authority to designate zones within the City where on-street parking will be regulated by pay stations and/or time limits. The City Manager, or his or her designee, shall have the authority to establish rates for such pay stations based on market rates. For purposes of this section, "market rates" shall mean the rate at which a 15 percent on-street vacancy rate per nationally recognized standards is achieved. All revenues from pay stations are hereby designated for payment into the Parking Enterprise Fund. The City Manager, or his or her designee, is hereby directed to create a Parking Management Advisory Task Force, which shall assist the City Manager, or his or her designee, with the establishment and management of the herein established on-street parking system. Once created, the Parking Management Advisory Task Force shall report to the Environment and Public Works Committee on its activities and recommendations on an annual basis.
