RESOLUTION NO. 39339

A RESOLUTION relating to historic preservation; adding the proposed landmark to the Tacoma Register of Historic Places and imposing controls for the following property: Epworth LeSourd United Methodist Church, located at 710 South Anderson Street; said landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Commission under Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code.

WHEREAS the Tacoma Landmarks and Historic Districts Code,
Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC"), establishes a procedure for
the designation and preservation of structures and areas having historical, cultural,
architectural, archaeological, engineering, or geographic importance, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to TMC 13.07.050, the nomination of the Epworth LeSourd United Methodist Church, located at 710 South Anderson Street ("Property"), currently owned and operated by Tacoma Musical Playhouse, was submitted by the owner for inclusion on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places, along with the requisite application materials, and

WHEREAS the Landmarks Preservation Commission ("Commission")
reviewed the request on October 14, 2015, and held a public hearing on
November 18, 2015, to receive public comment on the historic significance of the
Property, and

WHEREAS, according to TMC 13.07.040, the Commission found that the Property meets the eligibility requirements for listing on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places, and

WHEREAS, based upon said findings, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to designate the Property described below



as a historic landmark and place it on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. Designation. That, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC"), the City Council of Tacoma approves the designation of the following Property as a historic landmark and places said property on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places:

(1) Epworth LeSourd United Methodist Church

More particularly described as: 710 South Anderson Street, Tacoma, WA 98405

Parcel: 4945000120

That portion of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 20 North, Range 03 East, W.M. more particularly described as follows:

Lots 1 through 6, inclusive, in Block 4, Kennedy's Addition to Tacoma, Washington, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 5 of Plats at Page 13, records of Pierce County, Washington.

Situate in the City of Tacoma, County of Pierce, State of Washington;

based upon satisfaction of the following standards of TMC 13.07.040:

- A. Is associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history;
- C. Embodies the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction, or represents the work of a master, or possesses high artistic values, or represents a significant and distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction; and

F. Owing to its unique location or singular physical characteristics, represents an established and familiar visual feature of the neighborhood or City.

Section 2. Controls. A Certificate of Approval must be obtained from the Landmarks Preservation Commission, pursuant to TMC 13.05.047 et seq., or the time for denying an application for a Certificate of Approval must have expired before the owner may make alterations or changes to the following property:

1. Epworth LeSourd United Methodist Church: Changes to exterior of the principle structure, but excluding any changes to the surrounding landscaping or site.

ORDINANCE NO. 28338

WHEREAS Exhibit "A" describes the proposed modifications to the Biennial Budget, and Exhibit "B" provides a narrative detail about the modifications; Now, Therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the Biennial Budget of the City for fiscal years 2015-2016 is hereby amended by adopting the proposed 2015-2016 biennial modifications set out in Exhibit "A" and explained in narrative form in Exhibit "B," which exhibits are attached hereto and incorporated as part of this ordinance.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed to make interfund transfers and contributions, and that the Biennial

ORDINANCE NO. 28339

An ordinance relating to tax rates; amending Title 6 of the Tacoma Municipal Code by amending Chapters 6A.40, 6A.50, 6A.90, and 6A.100, authorizing an additional 1.5% earning tax on natural gas, electric and phone companies, generating approximately \$90 million over the next ten years, providing increased funding for street repair and improvements.

WHEREAS Proposition 3, proposing the authorization of an additional 1.5% earning tax on natural gas, electric and phone companies, was passed by the voters in the November 2015 general election, and

WHEREAS the election was certified on November 24, 2015, and
WHEREAS the proposed amendments to Title 6A of the Tacoma
Municipal Code ("TMC") would authorize an increase to the current tax rates of
6% to 7.5%, requiring amendments to TMC Chapters: (1) 6A.40,
Communications Tax, (2) 6A.50 Electricity Business and Solid Waste
Collection, (3) 6A.90 Natural or Manufactured Gas Tax and (4) 6A.100 Utilities
Gross Earnings Tax – Public Utilities, and

WHEREAS the proposed amendments would authorize an additional 1.5% earning tax on natural gas, electric and phone companies, generating approximately \$90 million over the next ten years, providing increased funding for street repair and improvements, and

WHEREAS the City plans to impose the new tax rates effective March 1, 2016; Now, Therefore,



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Title 6 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended by amending Chapters 6A.40, 6A.50, 6A.90, and 6A.100 thereof, to read as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A."

Section 2. That the effective date of the new tax rates is March 1, 2016.

There is hereby imposed upon the Power, Water, and Rail Divisions of the Department of Public Utilities taxes upon the gross earnings of said divisions and each of them at the following rates of gross earnings, for the benefit of the General Fund of the City: upon the Power Division, 6-7.5 percent, except for gross earnings derived from cable television activity for which the rate shall be 8 percent; and upon the Water and Rail Divisions, 8 percent; which taxes however shall be subordinate to any payments required to be made by any of said divisions from said gross earnings into any fund or funds heretofore or hereafter created for the payment of the principal of and interest on revenue bonds of the City heretofore or hereafter issued.

6A.100.020 Solid Waste Utility and Sewer Utility – Department of Public Works.

There is hereby imposed upon the Solid Waste Utility Division of the Department of Public Works, and upon the Sewer Utility of the Department of Public Works, for the benefit of the General Fund of the City, a tax upon the gross earnings of said utilities of 8 percent of said gross earnings, except that earnings from the activity involved in the sale of electricity or natural gas shall be taxed at the rate of 6-7.5 percent. The tax shall, however, be subordinate to any payments required to be made by any of said divisions from said gross earnings into any fund or funds heretofore or hereafter created for the payment of the principal of and interest on revenue bonds of the City heretofore or hereafter issued. Said taxes are hereby found to be reasonable and not disproportionate to the amount of taxes which said divisions or subdepartments would pay if operated as private utilities.
