### Resolution No. 39728

WHEREAS the new Amtrak Cascade Station ("Station") at Freighthouse Square is scheduled for completion this fall, and

WHEREAS, over the last four years, the community, City staff, and the City Council have been actively involved in the Station design, and

WHEREAS the Washington State Department of Transportation ("WSDOT") desires to partner with the City for the installation of a large scale, tile Historic Interpretive Display ("Display") to be located inside the Station and visible from the street, and

WHEREAS the Display was developed by Historic Tacoma and endorsed by the Amtrak Station Citizen Advisory Committee, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the State Participation Agreement, the City will be fully reimbursed for all costs related to the installation, estimated at \$233,841, including contingency, and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2017, the proposed project Display and background were presented to the City Council; Now, Therefore,

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# **RESOLUTION NO. 39733**

A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Fire Fighters Union, Local 31.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 39283, adopted October 6, 2015, authorized the execution of the 2015-2018 Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Fire Fighters Union, Local 31 ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for a wage increase of approximately 2 percent for an employee in the classification of Fire Medical Services Officer with 25 or more years of service, in order to maintain parity with the application of rate for an Administrative Fire Battalion Chief assigned to a 40-hour per week schedule, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Fire
