WHEREAS Summer Jobs 253 is a City of Tacoma-led summer youth employment program that has been in operation since 2013, and

WHEREAS the City contracts with Tacoma Community House/REACH
Center for services related to the Summer Jobs 253 program, including payroll
services; case management services; and outreach to, and engagement of,
employers that host student participants, and

WHEREAS, for 2017, the total cost of the program is \$536,376, and the City's portion of the program cost is \$308,375; Now, Therefore,

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## **RESOLUTION NO. 39750**

A RESOLUTION relating to funding for a crisis residential center; authorizing the execution of an agreement with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority, in the amount of \$700,000, budgeted from the Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Fund, to assist with the development of a Youth Crisis Residential Center.

WHEREAS the Tacoma Housing Authority ("THA") owns a 3.5 acre parcel adjacent to the Salishan neighborhood and buffered by First Creek Gulch, and

WHEREAS THA is proposing to use one acre of the said land to develop a one story, 5,000 square-foot Youth Crisis Residential Center ("Project"), to include 12 dorm-style bedrooms, two common bathrooms, a staff office, kitchen and living room space, and on-site parking, and

WHEREAS the Project is a result of a larger planning effort between the City, Pierce County, Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority ("TCRA"), and THA, and

WHEREAS the Project will serve a limited clientele that meets the definition of a public purpose for Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds, and is consistent with the City's Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development 2015-2019, which is the implementation document for the City's Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS the Consolidated Plan places a high priority on the development of affordable housing for low-income households, reducing homelessness, and increasing stability for all residents, including support for self-sufficiency, and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2017, the TCRA Board authorized staff to negotiate and execute a 30-year forgivable loan agreement, deed of trust, promissory note,



and regulatory agreement with the THA for \$1,000,000, for Project construction and permanent financing costs, and

WHEREAS the \$1,000,000 agreement between the TCRA and THA is proposed to be funded as follows: \$300,000 in TCRA CDBG funds and \$700,000 from the City, budgeted from the Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Fund, and

WHEREAS City staff recommends the approval of this agreement with the TCRA, in the amount of \$700,000, to assist in funding the Project; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority, in the amount of \$700,000, budgeted from the Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Fund, to assist with the development of a Youth Crisis Residential Center, said agreement to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39751**

A RESOLUTION relating to City-owned surplus real property; authorizing the execution of a Quit Claim Deed to convey 1120 and 1124 Martin Luther King Jr. Way to the Tacoma Housing Authority in accordance with the Purchase and Sale Agreement dated October 16, 2013, and approved pursuant to Resolution No. 38718, adopted August 13, 2013.

WHEREAS, in 2005, as part of the James L. Walton Hilltop Renaissance project, the City acquired the properties located at 1120 and 1124 Martin Luther King Jr. Way ("Property"), and

WHEREAS, since 2011, the Property has been leased to and operated by Morris McCollum, d/b/a Mr. Mac Ltd., at the current rate of \$720 per month, and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the City Council passed Resolution No. 38718, approving the surplus and disposition of the Property to the Tacoma Housing Authority ("THA") for development of its planned affordable housing project ("Project"), and

WHEREAS this Property is being donated to ensure the creation of affordable housing and preservation of mixed-income demographics in the Hilltop neighborhood, and

WHEREAS THA has extended its Project timeline to 2018, as it continues to pursue financing, and has agreed to take ownership and assume management of the Property and existing lease in the interim, and

WHEREAS lease revenue from the Property will assist in covering the costs of property management and maintenance, and

WHEREAS the conveyance will be subject to Covenants and Conditions that establish development performance and sets dates for submitting permits and starting construction, and



WHEREAS the Property will revert back to the City if THA fails to meet the conditions of sale, and

WHEREAS the Community and Economic Development Department recommends approval of a Quit Claim Deed to convey the subject Property to the THA, subject to the Covenants and Conditions establishing development requirements and performance dates; Now, Therefore,

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed to convey 1120 and 1124 Martin Luther King Jr. Way to the Tacoma Housing Authority in accordance with the Purchase and Sale Agreement dated October 16, 2013, and approved pursuant to Resolution No. 38718, adopted August 13, 2013, said deed to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
