## **RESOLUTION NO. 39922**

A RESOLUTION relating to surplus property, authorizing the Declaration of 1 Surplus and execution of a Quitclaim Deed to convey two parcels, located 2 at 5402 South Puget Sound Avenue and 3520 South 54th Street, and 5401 and 5407 South Tacoma Way, to Eli Moreno for the amount 3 of \$850,000. 4 WHEREAS, on January 27, 2017, the City purchased these Properties 5 located at 5402 South Puget Sound Avenue and 3520 South 54th Street, and 6 7 5401 and 5407 South Tacoma Way ("Properties"), for the purpose of 8 redeveloping the Properties for use as a youth and young adult drop-in center 9 and overnight shelter; following acquisition of the Properties, a feasibility study 10 determined the available space would not accommodate the needs of serving the 11 youth and young adult population at this location, and 12 WHEREAS the Properties, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A," 13 14 are now surplus to the City's needs, and 15 WHEREAS the proposed purchaser, Eli Moreno, plans to develop the 16 Properties into a co-work space, and has offered to pay the City the full asking 17 price of \$850,000, with payments spread over five years, and 18 WHEREAS the City must dispose of City-owned surplus property pursuant 19 20 to the City's Policy for the Sale/Disposition of City-owned General Government 21 Real Property, and 22 WHEREAS, there being no foreseeable need for continued City ownership 23 of the Properties, the sale of said Properties appears to be in the best interests of 24 25 the City, pending final approval from the City Council; Now, Therefore, 26 - 1 -
