A RESOLUTION setting Tuesday, February 19, 2019, as the date for a public 1 hearing on the proposed accessory dwelling unit regulations, as recommended by the Planning Commission and modified by the 2 Infrastructure, Planning and Sustainability Committee. 3 WHEREAS detached accessory dwelling units ("ADU") in single-family 4 zoning districts are currently permitted only through the Residential Infill Pilot 5 Program ("Pilot Program"), enacted in 2015 and codified as Tacoma Municipal 6 7 Code ("TMC") 13.05.115, and 8 WHEREAS the Pilot Program is intended to promote innovative residential 9 infill which is well-designed and harmonious with neighborhood patterns, and 10 WHEREAS, since the Pilot Program was established, there has been 11 substantial interest in constructing more than the three detached ADUs allowed 12 13 through the program, and 14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 39886, adopted on December 12, 15 2017, the City Council requested that the Planning Commission study the possibility 16 of increasing the number of detached ADUs allowed through the Pilot Program, and 17 WHEREAS, after subsequent recommendations from the Infrastructure, 18 19 Planning and Sustainability ("IPS") Committee and community input through the 20 Planning Commission process, the recommendation instead would remove 21 detached ADUs from the Pilot Program and allow them more broadly under the 22 updated ADU regulations, and 23 WHEREAS, on October 17, 2018, the Planning Commission forwarded 24 25 recommendations to the City Council for amendments to the City's ADU 26 regulations, and

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WHEREAS the IPS Committee discussed the proposals on December 12, 1 2018, and forwarded a modified ADU regulations package to the City Council on 2 January 23, 2019, for consideration, and 3 WHEREAS the proposed recommendations would modify the City's current 4 ADU regulations by allowing detached ADUs in single-family zoning districts; 5 6 simplifying regulatory requirements; reducing regulatory barriers; and generally 7 increasing flexibility regarding building design, size, and location, and 8 WHEREAS the recommendations also include design, building, and 9 ownership controls intended to ensure ADUs fit the scale and character of the 10 residential lot and surrounding neighborhood, and 11 12 WHEREAS, pursuant to TMC 13.02, the City Council is required to conduct 13 a public hearing before enacting any amendments to the Land Use Regulatory 14 Code, and 15 WHEREAS the City desires to fix a time and date for public hearing for the 16 purpose of considering the proposed ADU regulations, as recommended by the 17 Planning Commission and modified by the Infrastructure, Planning and 18 19 Sustainability Committee; Now, Therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA: 21 Section 1. That Tuesday, February 19, 2019, at approximately 5:30 p.m., is 22 hereby fixed as the time, and the City Council Chambers on the First Floor of the 23 24 Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, as the place 25 when and where a public hearing shall be held on the proposed accessory dwelling 26

4	WHEREAS, from 1992 through 2005, the City contracted with the		
5	Tacoma-Pierce County Humane Society ("Humane Society") for animal		
6	sheltering, control, and licensing services, and		
7 8	WHEREAS, beginning January 1, 2006, the City assumed responsibility for		
9	animal control and licensing services and, since that time, has continued to		
10	contract with the Humane Society for animal sheltering services, and		
11	WHEREAS these services are vital to City residents and the City's Animal		
12	Control staff for the boarding, keeping, and care of lost, abandoned, and injured

19	animals taken to the Humane Society, and		
20	WHEREAS the higher CPI in 2018 and additional medical expenses		
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22	resulted in actual costs exceeding the approved agreement amount by \$20,225,

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RESOLUTION NO. 40222

A RESOLUTION relating to animal control; authorizing the execution of an 1 agreement with the Tacoma-Pierce County Humane Society, in the amount of \$1,015,000, budgeted from the General Fund, for animal sheltering 2 services for the years 2019-2020. 3 WHEREAS, from 1992 through 2005, the City contracted with the 4 Tacoma-Pierce County Humane Society ("Humane Society") for animal 5 sheltering, control, and licensing services, and 6 7 WHEREAS, beginning January 1, 2006, the City assumed responsibility for 8 animal control and licensing services and, since that time, has continued to 9 contract with the Humane Society for animal sheltering services, and 10 WHEREAS these services are vital to City residents and the City's Animal 11 Control staff for the boarding, keeping, and care of lost, abandoned, and injured 12 13 animals, and 14 WHEREAS, when negotiations began in May 2018, the Humane Society 15 indicated that the contracts with the City and other jurisdictions have not been 16 sufficient to cover the cost of care for animals brought to the shelter by Animal 17 Control Officers and citizens for several years, and 18 19 WHEREAS, in September 2018, a performance audit was completed by the 20 Pierce County Auditor's Office to determine the actual costs of caring for animals 21 sheltered by the Humane Society, and the audit determined an estimated cost per 22 animal of \$195, and 23 WHEREAS the Humane Society and City have agreed to a proposed 24 25 service contract in lieu of a fee-per-animal contract, which caps the number of 26 charges per pet to the 2018 count, estimated to be 4,000, and provides for a



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	3 percent cost-of-living adjustment in 2020, as well as all necessary medical
