A resolution setting Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at approximately 5:15 p.m., as the date for a public hearing by the City Council on the establishment of a proposed Joint Base Lewis McChord Airport Compatibility Overlay District.

**RESOLUTION NO. 40325** 

A RESOLUTION setting Tuesday, June 4, 2019, as the date for a public hearing before the City Council on the establishment of a proposed Joint Base Lewis McChord ("JBLM") Airport Compatibility Overlay District, corresponding with JBLM's designated Accident Potential Zone II.

WHEREAS Joint Base Lewis McChord ("JBLM") is a vital military and economic asset that contributes approximately \$10 billion to the South Sound economy and provides tens of thousands of jobs for the region, and

WHEREAS the JBLM Joint Land Use Study ("Study") is a collaborative process among federal, regional, and local governments and agencies; tribes; the public; and the south Puget Sound region's military installations, JBLM and Camp Murray, for the purpose of promoting safety and reducing the risk of loss of life should a military aircraft accident occur, and

WHEREAS the Study area generally encompasses those communities within two miles of the JBLM boundary, which includes the City, and

WHEREAS the City has been working on the Study, in collaboration with other area jurisdictions, since at least 1992 in order to ensure that compatibility between the City and its citizens and JBLM is maintained, and

WHEREAS, within Accident Potential Zone II ("APZ II") areas, the recommendation is to institute changes to permitted land uses and development standards to prevent significant increases in density in order to reduce the risk of loss of life and damage on the ground, should an air accident occur, and

WHEREAS the proposed Airport Compatibility Overlay District would implement the recommendations of the JBLM Study and the U.S. Air Force's Air



Installations Compatible Use Zones Program, as well as implementing policy direction from the City's Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS these policy documents call for the City to incorporate considerations in local planning and permitting processes to address the health and safety of residents within areas potentially impacted by JBLM aircraft operations, and

WHEREAS the proposed JBLM Airport Compatibility Overlay District was presented to the Infrastructure, Planning and Sustainability Committee at its meeting of March 27, 2019, and the committee recommended that it be forwarded to the City Council for consideration, and

WHEREAS the City desires to fix a time and date for public hearing for the purpose of considering the proposed establishment of a proposed JBLM Airport Compatibility Overlay District corresponding with JBLM's designated Accident Potential Zone II; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Tuesday, June 4, 2019, at approximately 5:15 p.m., is hereby fixed as the time, and the City Council Chambers on the First Floor of the Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, as the place when and where a public hearing shall be held on the establishment of a proposed Joint Base Lewis McChord ("JBLM") Airport Compatibility Overlay District corresponding with JBLM's designated Accident Potential Zone II.
