RESOLUTION NO. 40638

A RESOLUTION relating to the vacation of City right-of-way; setting Thursday, October 1, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., as the date for a hearing before the City of Tacoma Hearing Examiner on the petition of Lee Pate, to vacate a portion of the undeveloped north side of South 62nd Street right-of-way, to cure an encroachment.

WHEREAS Lee Pate, having received the consent of the owners of more than two-thirds of the properties abutting the portion of the undeveloped north side of South 62nd Street right-of-way, has petitioned for the vacation of the following legally described right-of-way area:

A PORTION OF THE NORTH HALF OF SOUTH 62ND STREET SITUATED BETWEEN SOUTH JUNETT STREET AND SOUTH PINE STREET, BEING WITHIN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 20 NORTH, RANGE 03 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS;

ORDINANCE NO. 28616
