1	BY REQUEST OF COUNCIL MEMBER McCARTHY			
2				
3	budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, for media and broadcasting costs for the 2021 Pierce County Opioid Summit.			
4	WHEREAS, in 2017, the Pierce County Council declared a "State of Opioid			
5 6	Crisis" which paralleled a Presidential declaration, and sent a letter to Governor			
7	Inslee, urging him to declare Pierce County in a state of emergency, and			
8	WHEREAS, in that same year, representatives from multiple sectors were			
9				
10	convened as the Tacoma-Pierce County Opioid Task Force ("Task Force"), and			
11	WHEREAS, in February 2018, the Task Force convened a community			
12	summit on the opioid epidemic to get input for an action plan, and more than			
13	150 leaders from cities, healthcare, social services, fire, public health, law			
14	enforcement, and criminal justice joined together in discussion, and			
15	WHEREAS Task Force leaders have continued to meet annually to			
16 17	exchange ideas and coordinate efforts to end the opioid epidemic in Pierce County,			
18	and			
19	WHEREAS, in March 2020, the Coronavirus emerged, infecting millions			
20	worldwide and disrupting the way people in Pierce County live, work, and receive			
21	healthcare, and

23	WHEREAS the impact of this virus has left many communities scrambling for			
24	resources, technology, education, and means to support themselves and or their			
25	families financially, and

	WHEREAS, among those impacted are several vulnerable populations,			
1	including those without housing, reliable transportation, broadband, or access to			
2	treatment, who experience even higher levels of stress and isolation, and			
3 4	WHEREAS it has been reported that severe and prolonged levels of stress,			
5	when combined with iceletion, have been linked to higher rates of enjoid related			
6	overdoses, and			
7	WHEREAS, at the February 16, 2021, Study Session, Council			
8	Member McCarthy shared a Council Consideration Request to use \$2,000 of City			
9 10	Council Contingency Funding for media and broadcasting costs for the			
11	2021 Pierce County Opioid Summit, and			
12	WHEREAS the Task Force Steering Committee will share outcomes from			
13	the Summit with the City Council, and			
14	WHEREAS RCW 35.33.145 and 35.34.250 authorize a withdrawal from the			
15 16	City Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent			
17	of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of			
18	adopting the budget, and			
19	WHEREAS the need for funding related to the 2021 Pierce County Opioid			
20	Summit could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time the City			
21 22	adopted its biennial budget, and			
23	WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less			
24	than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now,
