A RESOLUTION relating to the multi-family property tax exemption program; 1 authorizing the execution of a Multi-Family Housing 12-Year Limited Property 2 Tax Exemption Agreement with Meacham Development, LLC, for the development of six multi-family market-rate and affordable rental housing 3 units to be located at 2420 South "I" Street, in the Downtown Regional Growth Center. 4 5 WHEREAS the City has, pursuant to chapter 84.14 of the Revised Code of 6 Washington, designated several Residential Target Areas for the allowance of a 7 limited property tax exemption for new multi-family residential housing, and 8 WHEREAS the City has, through Ordinance No. 25789, enacted a program 9 10 whereby property owners in Residential Target Areas may qualify for a Final 11 Certificate of Tax Exemption which certifies to the Pierce County 12 Assessor-Treasurer that the owner is eligible to receive a limited property tax 13 exemption, and 14 WHEREAS Meacham Development, LLC is proposing to develop six new 15 16 market-rate and affordable rental housing units to consist of: 17 Number of Units Type of Unit Average Size Market Rate 18 4 One bedroom, one bath 450 Square Feet 19 Affordable Rate One bedroom, one bath 450 Square Feet 2 20 WHEREAS the affordable units will be rented to households whose income 21 22 is at or below 70 percent of Pierce County Area Median Income, adjusted for 23 household size, as determined by the Department of Housing and Urban 24 Development on an annual basis, and rent will be capped at 30 percent of those 25 income levels, adjusted annually, and 26
