I have also read the Washington State's Chapter 236, Laws of 2020 and I quote, "It is the intent of the legislature that implementation of the social equity program authorized by this act not result in an increase in the number of marijuana retailer licenses above the limit on the number of marijuana retailer licenses in the state established by the board before January 1, 2020."

In reading on the WA State Liquor and Cannabis Board not in any of the applications to apply for a cannabis license did they ask what your ethnicity is? In resolution 40627 it specifically states the word "Black Americans". Chapter 236 is for a social equity applicant who resides in a disproportionately impacted area not a certain ethnicity. It seems divisive when many of us are trying to be more equitable.

Black Excellence In Cannabis thanks Deputy Mayor Keith Blocker for meeting with us and The Cannabis Alliance on 06/25/20. Where we presented our proposal for a plan which would allow Tacoma to lead the way for creating an inclusive cannabis industry that allows People of Color to benefit from the economic opportunities created by legalization (included below).

Blacks were arrested at 4 times the rate of Whites for cannabis yet own less than 1% of the available licenses. White men are now licensed to sell cannabis in Black Communities and extract millions of dollars. The WSLCB's unchecked discriminatory practices, greed, corruption and hypocrisy have led us to this shameful and inequitable place.

Black Excellence In Cannabis is working for effective social equity and social justice in Washington's cannabis industry. Black Entrepreneurs who helped build this industry into the \$6 Billion giant that it is today, are locked out of the regulated industry. Last legislative session we worked hard in Olympia to lobby for effective social equity legislation for the State but were unsuccessful. BEC has petitioned Governor Insee and his WSLCB to address this issue but has been met with attempts to subvert our movement and discredit us. This led us to search for solutions on a local level.

The City of Tacoma being made up of 35% People of Color means that it is one of the most greatly harmed by the exclusion and disenfranchisement of minorities. This also means that Tacoma also stands to gain the most by leading the way for minority inclusion. There is a lot of money at stake. Those who put this inequitable system in place, and those who are benefiting from it, are highly motivated to maintain the status quo. They are not above using "leaders" from our community to launch personal attacks or obstruct the process. BEC hopes to work with Tacoma in an open process to implement real solutions and we pray that the City's leadership will see any unproductive behavior for what it is and focus on productive activity that achieves results.

Honorable Mayor Woodards and City Council Members,

I'm writing to express my concerns about the Pierce Transit BRT project.

I live on Pacific Avenue. I have been a public transit user in Tacoma, Seattle, Washington DC, Los Angeles, San Francisco, London, Paris, and other locations. I am a big proponent of public transportation. Moreover, I am in the design and construction profession and have worked at Sound Transit.

The Pacific Avenue BRT project appears to be an overbuilt vanity project for Pierce Transit. The proposed construction will negatively impact community small businesses who rely on their parking. The stations are too large for the locations and will impede car and pedestrian traffic. They will be targets for vandalism and undesirable behavior. Ask Sound Transit how an old streetcar platform became a public toilet.

We already have a very welcome Pacific Avenue bus service that could have other upgrades – shadow buses at peak times, an express hub-to-hub that uses the freeway, increased paratransit service, for examples.

The cost to taxpayers and PT customers is terribly outsized compared to the benefits. At a time of layoffs, furloughs, and struggling businesses, it makes Tacoma look bad to take public money and fares from people in distressed economic circumstances to build “billboards” for Pierce Transit. I feel that Pierce Transit has not been truthful about the need and justification for this project, now rather than in 20-30 years in the future. I'm ashamed that our local public transportation agency has misappropriated the real goals of public transportation. Please save us from this debacle.

My name is Alexander Kenesson, and I've been a resident in Proctor District, Tacoma for about 5 years now. I'm emailing to provide comment for the Community Forum that I will regrettably be unable to attend this Tuesday, July 14, 2020.

I would like to affirm and re-affirm my desires to see a drastic reduction in 2021-2022 budget allocations for the Tacoma Police Department, and have that funding redistributed to programs that can benefit community programs (preferably in historically marginalized areas) that can prevent crime occurring in the first place. Specifically I'd like to see increased funding for things like K-12 education, substance abuse programs, treatment, and care, homelessness prevention/assistance, mental health therapy, and social programs and/or counseling.

We are sincerely looking forward to today's city council meeting. We will share these comments there as well, however we are still looking for engagement from our council members, mayor and city manager. This is our fifth public comment submitted over the past month or so, with not one reply.

One important update is specifically from District 4. Yesterday, a member of our Tacoma community who is houseless was having a mental and addiction health crisis. The Pierce County Crisis folks are both under resourced and under developed. Not only did it take 20 minutes for the call to get picked up, but we were told it would take 6 hours to have the crisis team come out. The operator said normally she would suggest to call the police, but that we are in a "moment" and they are not coming out right now.

We need crisis infrastructure that are not police, and are actually helpful for our mental health, physical health, and addiction crises. We need those resources to be staffed adequately and to not be another entry point to the police. Further, we are concerned that the Tacoma Police Department is violating their contract by instituting a work slowdown or a partial work stoppage.

Sign to Demand Changes to Address Systemic Racism across and within TPS

We, the undersigned, call on Tacoma Public Schools (TPS) to live up to their core values of cultural understanding and equity. Also, to acknowledge that their vision of being "an outstanding school district in which all students exhibit high standards of achievement and critical thinking skills, and are socially responsible, contributing members of their community," cannot be fulfilled without meeting the following demands. The demands address the systemic racism within and across the Tacoma Public Schools System that consistently results in an achievement gap between white and Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) students.

We ask TPS to acknowledge and follow the lead of other school districts in Washington state, such as Seattle Public Schools, Spokane Public Schools, and Vancouver Public Schools, that are already meeting similar demands. We also acknowledge that the Tacoma Education Association is similarly petitioning to remove school resource officers (SROs) from TPS.

With this petition, we demand to see the following changes reflected at a district level and at each TPS campus:

1. **Create a race and equity advisory council of Black, Indigenous, and People of Color students, families, and educators at the district level.** The council members will be assembled from established BIPOC community organizations in Tacoma. The council will be inclusive and diverse, and authorized to (i) craft a comprehensive plan of curricula to address systemic racism, police brutality, and white supremacy at all levels of education; (ii) develop that plan with the community; and (iii) implement the updated curricula by the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. TPS should understand that a complete and detailed list of demands is to be decided on by the race and equity advisory council, with the following demands needing immediate attention.
2. **Remove Tacoma Police Department from all Tacoma Public Schools, and cancel the district relationship between TPD and TPS.** [Academic studies](#) directly link more police to worse academic outcomes for students.

3. **Reallocate the \$2.15 million allotted to SROs over the next five years, as well as additional funding, to the five following demands.**
4. **De-escalation training and transformative justice training within campuses and across the district.**
5. **Mandate Black history and ethnic studies at all grade levels.** TPS is omitting Black students from their “the whole child” approach. It is impossible to [facilitate mental health and psychological liberation among Black youth](#) without teaching Black history.
6. **Mandate [culturally responsive pedagogy training](#) for all educators.** Again, TPS educators cannot teach “the whole child” effectively without gaining cultural awareness.
7. **Hire and support more Black, Indigenous, and People of Color teachers.** [Research](#) shows that having a Black teacher, in particular, does a lot of good for students, especially students of color.
8. **Hire more Black, Indigenous and People of color school counselors, and Family Support Liaisons .** [BIPOC students need counselors and support that can empathize with the unique challenges and circumstances they face.](#) For this reason, every effort should also be made to hire BIPOC school staff such as librarians and nurses.

4. Review the many existing community safety and crisis assistance models ([Crisis Response Unit](#), [CAHOOTS](#), [Safe Passage](#), [Sista II Sista](#)), and transformative justice practices, and develop a new way to uplift and protect our families and neighbors who have been systematically marginalized, silenced, disenfranchised, erased, and brutalized.
