My name is Jennifer Chernut and I am a resident of Tacoma's 4th District. I previously submitted public comments to the council after my house was shot up on May 6th in a drive by shooting, incident 2212601562. Subsequent to this shooting, 8 people have been shot within 500ft of my house.

I have been to Safe Streets meetings, Citizen Advisory and neighborhood council meetings, I speak with my neighbors. I report suspected issues. I attended the study session where Chief Moore and UTSA presented their crime reduction plan, which I have read every single line of.

On July 13th, Chief Moore spoke with a committee at my place of business, and I had the opportunity to share with him my experiences and ask him if there was a gang problem in Tacoma. I mentioned that the word on the street was that there is a gang turf war that is going on around the Tacoma Mall, yet the first time I even have heard the word gang mentioned was in a news report for Iyana Ussery. Chief Moore stated that the data the TPD have does not show that these crimes are committed by gangs.

Last week I visited SouthSound911 and obtained a copy of the police report from the May 6th incident where my house was shot: it is attached. What I found both frightening and alarming, is that there were multiple eyewitnesses, photos of the shooter's vehicle, surveillance footage, etc. and the primary suspect in this case is a known Hill Top Crip by the name Leeky, who has a felony warrant for his arrest.

I checked Pierce County Linx jail roster and Leeky is not incarcerated.

This past weekend, another shooting occurred on my block, where 40+ shots rang out. [I captured this footage on my ring camera](#) and shared with David Rose of Q13 and Gwen Baumgardner of KIRO, which both aired the footage. This is the 3rd time shooting footage of mine has been used in the media since May.

The address of the shooting, 1765 S 36th St, shooting just happens to be the address listed on Leeky's car registration (which you can find on p. 79 of the attached incident report). I also shared this with the media.

Now who knows where the next 40+ shooting will occur. I would bet my life that since Leeky's mom was shot, its going to be violent. Leeky roams free while me and my 16 year old daughters are prisoners in our house, afraid to leave.

I am beyond frustrated with the lack of leadership from this city, so much so that I have had to contact the media to get answers. But once again, the leadership of this city is invisible. There has been no visibility of City Manager Pauli, no visibility of Mayor Woodards, and no presence of Police Chief Moore. In any other major city, there is a presence of the Mayor, Chief of Police, or City Manager, whether good or bad.

I expressed my frustrations with both David Rose and Gwen Baumgardner about why we don't have answers. [By the looks of last night's broadcast](#) once again city leadership did not make themselves available, yet Pierce County Sheriff PIO Darren Moss was available.

So the questions that I have that I and my fellow constituents are entitled to answers for are:

Why has someone with a felony arrest warrant who is a known gang member and the prime suspect on a drive-by shooting not been arrested?

Why is my block, which has had so much violence over a short period of time, not considered a hot spot?

Why does our Chief of Police not seem to know that there is a gang problem here?

1 Why are the leaders of this city so apathetic about this violence?

Why won't our elected and appointed officials make themselves available to the media?

What can we do to reinstate the Gang Task Force?

When can I expect my answers?

Subject: Comments on Escalating Violence

Mayor Woodward, Deputy Mayor Ushka, City Manager Pauli, and Councilmembers,

My name is Jennifer Chernut, and I am a homeowner residing at the corner of 35th and Chandler in District 4.

Friday May 6th at 5:46 pm, I was sitting on my couch when my house was struck by five bullets during a rolling shootout. One of the bullets came through my ceiling near my daughter's bedroom, and another bullet was about eighteen inches away from blowing my brains out.

This all occurred in broad daylight when people are coming home from work and preparing to sit down with their families for dinner.

Luckily, my next-door neighbor to the left of me was not at home, as two bullets pierced through the drywall of his living room. My neighbors across the street had both of their cars struck as did my neighbor to the right of me. I thank God it was raining at the time because the neighbor's grandchildren would normally be outside playing before dinner and would have been directly in the line of fire. I believe forensics recovered twenty-five shell casings from this shootout.

The following evening on Saturday, May 7th, there were two homicides in Tacoma.

Tacoma is now at 20 homicides in 2022, more than Seattle, which has over three times our population. The city is on track to have the deadliest year in history. I graduated from high school in 1994 and can recall the violence that was present in our city. Sadly, I have a high school sophomore that now refuses to leave our home in fear of being shot due to the same level of violence.

Our city is failing our citizens. The incident that took place in my neighborhood was carried out by scumbags who have been emboldened by our government. The council, the city manager's office, our legislators, and court systems have allowed violence to perpetuate through do-nothing policies.

The cowards that shot up my house did so with ZERO regard for human life, and with NO fear of consequence.

Your lack of leadership has created an environment here in Tacoma that will breed vigilantism. By abdicating police power and empowering criminals, you are encouraging citizens to take matters into their own hands. We have recently seen examples of local vigilantism with grim results. Nonetheless, I will not live in fear and will defend myself, my family, and my home.

Your inaction on public safety has and will continue to cost lives. Our city needs proper policing and a City Manager and Council that empowers our Chief of Police and Law Enforcement to protect us. I implore you to give Chief Moore, his staff, and his pending Crime Reduction plan the support needed to have a fully staffed and empowered police force, proper response time, and a climate where criminals consider consequences instead of laughing at our institutions, our leaders, and our policies.

Who knows, next time it might be your home these bullets fly in front of while your children play in the front yard.

Correa as V/SIDIBE. Tacoma fire was already enroute and the vehicle that was rolled over at S 35th and Ainsworth was confirmed as being un-occupied. Tacoma Fire arrived shortly after I did.

I noticed several people out around the scene, so I began to locate witnesses. I first spoke with a male who identified himself as W/LEMUS. W/LEMUS said he was outside of his residence getting ready to walk to a nearby convenience store when he heard a loud boom. This was from the listed Mazda 3 crashing at the intersection of S 35th and Ainsworth Ave into a power pole. W/LEMUS walked out to the road and noticed the Mazda on its top on the N/W corner of the intersection. W/LEMUS did not see anyone in or around the vehicle. A red "older" 4 door then pulled up to S 35th and Ainsworth. The driver and sole occupant got out of the red car and went up to the Mazda. W/LEMUS said the driver of the red car grabbed what W/LEMUS believed was an AK-47 style rifle. The driver then got back into the red car and fled W/B on S 35th St then S/B on Asotin St. W/LEMUS described the driver of the red car as a B/M, in his 20's, wearing jeans, eyeglasses and a gray or blue shirt. W/LEMUS said the B/M grabbed the rifle from near the front driver's door.

I next spoke with a husband and wife who reside at 1601 S 35th St. The Mazda crashed and ended up on its top in the S/E corner of the front yard of this residence. The residents were identified as W/CAMILLE and W/THOMAS. Both residents are prior military with combat experience. Both residents said they heard multiple shots to the west of their residence. W/CAMILLE said she and W/THOMAS were in their living room which faces S 35th St watching television when they saw the power pole that the Mazda struck shake. W/CAMILLE looked out the window and saw the Mazda on its top and noticed what appeared to be bullet holes in the front passenger door. W/CAMILLE watched as a B/M associated with a red 4 door car exited the vehicle and approached the Mazda. The B/M grabbed what W/LEMUS believed was an AK-47 rifle lying on the ground near the rear passenger door. The male then got back into the red car and fled W/B on S 35th St.

W/CAMILLE described the B/M as being in his mid to late 20's, scruffy facial hair, short black hair, wearing black pants, and a black hoody. W/CAMILLE estimated that the red car the B/M was in was no more than 10 years old and appeared to be a Toyota. W/CAMILLE recalled that the first two letters on the license plate of the red car were "CH". W/CAMILLE went on to say that while her husband, (W/THOMAS) called 911 she grabbed a medical bag and contacted V/SIDIBE on the front porch of 1611 S 35th St. W/CAMILLE informed me that she used to be a combat medic in the military. W/CAMILLE treated V/SIDIBE's injury with gauze and a tourniquet. W/CAMILLE said while she treated V/SIDIBE, he advised that he had been the driver and sole occupant of the Mazda. V/SIDIBE also told W/CAMILLE that a subject in a silver SUV had shot him. V/SIDIBE also reportedly admitted to W/CAMILLE that the rifle the B/M had taken was his and added that it had belonged to his dad. V/SIDIBE said he hadn't even had a chance to shoot it yet.

I next spoke with W/THOMAS. W/THOMAS also said he had heard 12-15-gun shots. W/THOMAS said the shots sounded like they were .45cal, or .38 caliber rounds. W/THOMAS then also saw the power pole shake. W/THOMAS grabbed his kids and got them to a back room. W/THOMAS got his cell phone and called 911 while he walked out front. By this time W/CAMILLE was already tending to V/SIDIBE's injuries. W/THOMAS said he did not see the B/M grab the rifle, so it appears that this occurred prior to W/THOMAS going outside. W/THOMAS could hear V/SIDIBE yelling that someone had shot him while he was on the porch of 1611 S 35th St. I noticed that W/CAMILLE and W/THOMAS's residence had a camera on it. W/THOMAS reviewed the camera footage but did not locate anything of evidentiary value. W/THOMAS called the monitoring company for the camera system, but they confirmed that video footage is not automatically saved. I did not notice any other cameras in the area where the vehicle crashed.

I remained on scene until Bill's towing arrived for the Mazda. Forensics responded to the scene and processed it. I did not speak to any other involved parties or locate any other witnesses. Please see the other involved officers supplemental report for additional information. My BWC was activated during this incident.

Narrative:

On 5-6-22, I was on routine patrol driving a fully marked Tacoma Police patrol vehicle with a BWC (activated on this call) assigned as a one-officer car (P069). At 1747 hours, I was dispatched to the 1600 block of South 35th Street along with numerous other 3 and 4 Sector swing shift patrol units in reference to a shooting that had just occurred. Dispatch advised that multiple callers had called 911 beginning at 1746 hours to report that someone had been shot in front of 1611 South 35th Street. In addition, some of the callers reported hearing as many as 15-20 gunshots and that a vehicle had crashed and then flipped over near South 35th and Asotin Streets. Lastly, Dispatch advised that a male subject was seen running down a nearby street holding an AK-47-style rifle.

I arrived in the area and briefly assisted PPS Rose as he contacted the occupants of 1631 South 35th Street, which had been shot up. I then contacted V/CHERNUT, who lives next door at 1627 South 35th Street. V/CHERNUT then explained that the front of her house had numerous bullet holes in it. She and I then located three entry bullet holes in her front south-facing wall. The bullet holes were above her front door, at the bottom of the gutter downspout to the right of her front door if facing from the outside, and above her large south-facing living room window to the east of her front door. V/CHERNUT later began crying after telling me that the bullet hole above her living room window had only been a few feet above her head; she had been sitting on the living room couch directly below and against the same south side wall as the living room window at the time of the shooting. V/CHERNUT's juvenile daughter, V/Juvenile had also been inside the residence when it got shot up but had not been in the living room. V/CHERNUT then relayed the following:

V/CHERNUT stated that she was inside her residence when the incident began. V/CHERNUT then heard the sound of eight rapid fire gunshots from the street outside in front her residence. V/CHERNUT then heard the sound of glass breaking. V/CHERNUT then opened her front door and saw V/SIDIBE lying down on the front porch of 1611 South 35th Street screaming out in pain. V/CHERNUT then ran across Chandler Street towards where V/SIDIBE was lying. V/SIDIBE then yelled out, "They shot me for no reason! I didn't do anything!" V/SIDIBE then told V/CHERNUT to call 911, which she then did. V/CHERNUT did not see or hear anything else of note.

V/CHERNUT then checked her ring.com front door exterior surveillance camera footage, which shows a maroon in color four door sedan driving past westbound on South 35th Street shortly after the shooting. Upon further investigation, it appears that this vehicle may have contained the subject that took V/SIDIBE's AK-47-style rifle from his vehicle. I then contacted O/CHERNUT, who is V/CHERNUT's brother and who lives in a detached outbuilding behind V/CHERNUT's residence.

O/CHERNUT stated that he was inside his house when he heard the sound of a loud crash. O/CHERNUT then heard at least 15-20 rapid fire gunshots coming from the south in the general direction of where he just heard the crash. O/CHERNUT then ran outside towards South 35th Street. O/CHERNUT then saw V/SIDIBE and heard him yelling, "I'm shot! I got shot for no reason!" O/CHERNUT did not hear or see anything else related to the incident.

I then cleared the scene after hearing over the radio that V/SIDIBE sustained non-life-threatening injuries and that no CID callout would be initiated. After doing so, I advised Crime Scene Tech Sodon (I917) via radio of the bullet holes to V/CHERNUT's residence as well as her cell phone number to recover the video evidence from her cell phone.

Narrative:	<p>On 05/06/22 at approximately 1815hrs I (PPS MCNEELY) was operating as a fully marked one-officer car (P184) - equipped with a body worn camera. I was assigned as a Police Patrol Specialist on swing shift patrol in the City of Tacoma. I responded to the St Joseph Medical Center ER for a casualty report of a shooting victim, stemming from an incident in the South end of Tacoma.</p> <p>Upon my arrival I located V/SIDIBE in the ER, in Trauma Room #2 - under the care of DR PAUL INOUE. It should be noted that due to privacy concerns in the ER, my BWC was not activated. Medical staff were tending to V/SIDIBE'S lower right leg (calf and shin area) and were actively wrapping it in gauze. I was informed by DR INOUE that there were 3 total GSW's to the lower right leg - an entry (1) and exit (2), and then another entry wound (3) - one wound was a through and through, and the other entry - had apparently broken V/SIDIBE'S lower leg and the bullet was still lodged inside. DR INOUE informed me that the wounds were not life threatening.</p> <p>V/SIDIBE was very loud and seemed to be in a large amount of pain, however his main focus was on screaming for his cell phone. While medical staff were tending to him, I was able to get a TPD Medical Records Release form signed by him, and the following account of events:</p> <p>V/SIDIBE was driving when a smaller, older gray sedan (unsure if 2dr or 4dr) started shooting at him with at least 3 shooters. provide any more details as to what happened. I did ask him if he knew the shooters OR would recognize them if he saw them again. V/SIDIBE stated he did not know them, however did believe that he would recognize one if not all of the shooters if he saw them again. However, V/SIDIBE grew uncooperative and was unable/unwilling to provide me with any type of suspect description.

I relayed this information to PPO CHOHRACH (P-140), whom inquired if V/SIDIBE had been with anyone, or if he had any knowledge of the AK-47 that had been in V/SIDIBE's vehicle. PPO CHOHRACH advised that a witness had seen someone flee with after the wreck after taking an AK out of V/SIDIBE'S vehicle.

When asked directly about this, V/SIDIBE initially denied any knowledge of an AK-47 in the vehicle. However, after telling him that it was for an Officer Safety concern, he did admit that he had an AK in the car, and that it was his fathers. He initially stated that the AK was in the passenger seat next to him, but denied ever using it at all. He then changed his story, stating that the AK was in a backpack in the backseat of his vehicle, and that there were no "clips" with it. I confirmed with him that he meant no ammunition or magazines for the firearm, and he confirmed to me that that it what he had meant. V/SIDIBE denied being with anyone else, and then stated that the person that was seen taking the AK had robbed him and then shot him. When asked what he was robbed of, he stated \$850 - but again was unable/unwilling to elaborate on anything else pertaining to a robbery. While I was asking these questions, medical staff provided V/SIDIBE with a sedative - which effectively concluded the interview.

I relayed all the above information to PPO CHORACH, and inquired if there was anything else they needed from me at the hospital. PPO CHORACH requested that I take and book any property of V/SIDIBE'S, to include any cell phones. I collected V/SIDIBE'S newer black Iphone (in a black Otterbox case), and pair of underwear (which had been cut off) - which was the only property brought into the ER with V/SIDIBE. The phone and underwear were later booked into the property room as Evidence at TPD Headquarters.

This report is intended as a summary of events. I have paraphrased conversations and do not include an exact sequencing of events. For any exact quotes or exact sequencing of events I would refer the reader to my body worn camera footage, as it was recording at the time of this incident.

For any exact quotes or exact sequencing of events, I would refer the reader to my body worn camera footage, as it was recording at the time of this incident. On May 6, 2022 I was assigned as T334, a one-officer traffic car. I was in uniform and driving a marked patrol car.</p> <p>At 1746 hours I responded to reports of a shooting near the intersection of S 35th St/S Asotin St. As I neared the scene, dispatch updated that an involved vehicle had crashed and rolled over at S 35th St/S Ainsworth St. I arrived to find an unlicensed silver Mazda sedan on its roof on the northwest corner of the intersection. The vehicle was unoccupied.</p> <p>A male was shouting and clearly shot on a porch just a couple houses west of the crashed car. I walked to the intersection of S 35th St/S Asotin St to investigate what had occurred. Just south of the intersection on S Asotin St I noted numerous brass casings in the middle of the street, and another pile nearby on the west sidewalk.</p> <p>I spoke with V/JON WINSKIE and V/JENNA WINSKIE who reside at 3501 S Asotin St. They informed me that their vehicles, parked in front of their residence, had been struck by gunfire. V/JON WINSKIE and V/JENNA WINSKIE both reported that they had been sitting in their living room as the shooting erupted in front of their home. They observed a black male shooter, along with one or two others in the street in front before taking cover. Once the shooting subsided and a vehicle sped off they emerged from their home to find that their vehicles parked in front were struck by gunfire. Their pickup, bearing WA/C34475N was struck three times and their other vehicle bearing WA/BSK7274 was struck once as well. V/JON WINSKIE and V/JENNA WINSKIE completed handwritten statements which I collected and later submitted.</p>

I next spoke with W/SMITH as well in the 3500 block of S Asotin St. W/SMITH reported that he and several other family members were working on a drywall project midway down the block when they heard the gunfire. W/SMITH said his nephew injured his knee as they all "hit the deck" for fear of being struck by stray rounds. W/SMITH said that following the shooting he observed what he believed to be a 2007-2010 silver Infinity sedan coupe with a spoiler and tinted windows speed away.

As I continued my canvas of the block seeking witnesses or video footage I was flagged down by W/WILEY. W/WILEY informed me she had taken photos of the shooter's vehicle and asked if I would like them. W/WILEY said she was inside her home (3519 S Asotin St) with her grandfather when she heard the gunfire erupt. W/WILEY's grandfather said he saw three individuals in the street jump into a silver sedan (driven by a male who remained inside) that sped away. W/WILEY captured three photos of the vehicle with her cellphone, which she sent to my department email account. I viewed the photos, which appeared to depict a silver Infinity sedan as described by W/SMITH. I could not make out the figures of the front license plate depicted in one photo due to low resolution. I arranged for TPD Forensics to send W/WILEY an evidence.com link so she could upload the photos.

I distributed a copy of the photos to on duty officers countywide as an officer safety advisement. Nothing further.

On 5/6/2022, SS911 dispatch advised of a shooting taking place in the area of S 35th Street and S Asotin Street. I activated my emergency lights and sirens and proceeded to the location.

Upon arrival there was a group of people on S 35th Street between Chandler Street and S Ainsworth avenue. I observed a silver in color vehicle (WA-CBF1720) upside down on the NW corner of S 35th Street and S Ainsworth avenue. It was determined no one was inside the vehicle. Several folks pointed to the house on the NE corner of S 35th street and Chandler Street, 1611 S 35th Street. I went to the location and observed a black male, later identified as V/SIDIBE, lying on his left side on the front porch of the location. A white female, later identified as CAMILLE GRAY, was tending to V/SIDIBE's wounds and a white male was holding V/SIDIBE's hand. CAMILLE GRAY had applied a tourniquet prior to my arrival to the right leg of V/SIDIBE. I cut the right pant leg off V/SIDIBE to assess his wounds. I observed what appeared to be two (2) circular wounds on the right calf of V/SIDIBE. CAMILLE GRAY applied sterile gauze from a medical kit she had. Tacoma Fire personnel arrived and took over care of V/SIDIBE. It should be noted the white male holding the hand of V/SIDIBE relayed he was a neighbor, he did not see anything, only heard the commotion and decided to assist.

I observed the vehicle, (WA-CBF1720) that was upside down on the NW corner of S 35th street and S Ainsworth Avenue with what appeared to be two (2) bullet holes on the front right side and lots of shattered glass on the ground.

It appeared no one I spoke with lived at the 1611 S 35th street address, and no one answered the door. I asked SS911 dispatch if there was a listed homeowner for the address. SS911 dispatch relayed a possible owner was CHRISTIAN REY and provided a phone number. I attempted to make phone contact which went straight to voicemail with the mailbox being full. I left a blue incident card with the case number in the mailbox at the location. It should be noted this location appeared to have security cameras. There were two (2) vehicles (WA-CCH7892; TEMP WA-A5196787) in the driveway of this location however no one was

home. The registered owners of the vehicles were CHRISTIAN REY and PIUS KIM. Neighbors relayed the homeowner was in the military and frequently gone but would rent the location.

I contacted SS911 Records and requested a tow. The vehicle, (WA-CBF1720) was towed by Bill's Towing. Upon moving the vehicle, it appeared the pole (TP26905) next to the vehicle was not damaged, it is unknown if the vehicle struck the pole. However, there appeared to be a low hanging wire. TPU was notified.

I maintained scene security until Tacoma Forensics personnel were clear of the scene.

On 05/06/22 at 1747 hours multiple units responded to the report of a shooting st S. 30th St. and S. Asotin St. The first arriving units advised a gun shot victim was on a porch just east of the intersection. Multiple houses and vehicles were struck.

Upon arrival I was waved down by a bystander who was gesturing to me in front of 3508 S. Asotin St. I could see several bullet casings lying in the street. I left my vehicle to protect the shooting scene and the casings.

I contacted the residents of 1631 S. 30th St. (which had been struck twice). The vehicle parked out front (WA license BXU4297) had been struck through the front windshield and the round apparently broke out the front, passenger window as well.

I noticed several small children were present at the residence. I contacted the adults, V/YOUNG, V/GREEN and V/ADAMS. All 3 of them heard the shots being fired outside but luckily, no one was struck. V/ADAMS said she went to the front door after hearing the shots and saw a silver vehicle driving S/B on S. Asotin St. She believed it looked like a silver Mazda which has been known to be in the area.

I spoke to V/GREEN's grandchild (also a resident of the location), W/Juvenile. He said he was at the door and was looking out and saw a silver Lexus at the intersection. He said he could see someone get out of the car and fired approximately 6 rounds toward the east. W/Juvenile said he could only see the shooter's legs and they looked 'dark blue'. He said the Lexus then sped off S/B on S. Asotin St.

I located a bullet hole in the front door of the home. I saw the bullet continued on and struck the wall (over a doorway) and apparently ruptured a water line as a stream of water was falling from the hole. A 2nd bullet hole was located on the west side of the house (struck on the south side - facing the street). This bullet went through the wall and impacted into a small television, destroying it.

I stood by on scene while it was processed by Forensic Services.

During my time on scene, my department issued body worn camera was activated.

Synopsis:

Narrative:

This report is intended as a summary of events. I have paraphrased conversations and do not include an exact sequencing of events. For any exact quotes or exact sequencing of events I would refer the reader to my body worn camera footage, as it was recording at the time of this incident.

On 5/7/2022, I was working as a Police Patrol Officer for the City of Tacoma. During this shift I was assigned as a two-officer patrol unit with PPO R. Bradley. Several hours prior to starting our shift, Tacoma Police patrol units had responded to the area of 1500 S 35th St for the report of a driveby shooting.

During the course of that incident/investigation, PPO J. Levitt was told by a witness that a possible suspect vehicle used in the shooting was a silver 2007 - 2010 Infiniti sedan that was equipped with a spoiler. During that contact, he was provided with photographs of the vehicle, which he attached to the incident via MPS (Mobile for Public Safety).

At the start of shift, PPO R. Bradley and I reviewed the attached photos of the suspect vehicle. Although the photos appeared to be taken from a distance and were not completely clear, I could clearly see that the first three digits of the license plate were AWW. It also appeared that the fifth and sixth digits of the plate were 1's.

I conducted several checks for similar makes/model of vehicle using police resources without success.

Several hours later at approximately 0253 hours, while on an unrelated call, we observed a silver Infiniti G35 parked in the 6500 block of E Roosevelt Ave. The Washington License affixed to the vehicle was AWW6110. The vehicle was parked on the east side of the roadway, facing south. At the time of observation, the vehicle was unoccupied. The caller for this unrelated incident reported seeing several subjects carrying bags, exit the vehicle, and then walk behind 2217 E 65th St, out of sight.

We checked the vehicle, looking for any evidence of being damaged in a shooting or any of the described stolen property from this incident. On the rear, driver side passenger door, we observed what appeared to be a bullet hole, unknown from when, that had been covered with duct tape.

A check of the license plate, showed that it had been reported as a parking problem (TPD #2212601631) at 812 S 15th St. A silver car was reported to be unoccupied and partially blocking the alley at the location, and the license plate given was WA/AWW6110. The caller of that reported that four males exited the vehicle and then ran south towards S 16th St. No police contact was ever made with the reporting person, as the call was only broadcast to north end Tacoma patrol units. The reporting person advised dispatch that she had video of the vehicle being abandoned. It should be noted that the driveby shooting call was aired at 1746 hours and the reporting person of this complaint stated that the vehicle was abandoned at approximately 1752 hours.

There was no probable cause for any crime relating to this incident at this time, so the vehicle was left in the 6500 block of E Roosevelt Ave.

At the request of Sgt. D. Myhre, myself and CST K. Bendlin responded to 1611 S 35th St for a shooting incident.

Upon our arrival, CST K. Bendlin and I contacted Sgt. D. Myhre who provided us a briefing of the incident. It was decided I would process the shooting scene located at the intersection of S 35th St and S Asotin St while CST K. Bendlin processed the associated motor vehicle accident scene located at 1611 S 35th St.

I responded to the intersection of S 35th St and S Asotin St.

Upon my arrival, I contacted PPO D. Rose who advised the residence located at 1631 S 35th St had been struck twice. A resident of this address, Richard Young, showed me the suspected ballistic damage.

I observed one (1) suspected bullet hole through the upper east corner of the south facing entry door into the north wall above the kitchen entryway, and one (1) through the south facing exterior into the northwest bedroom, through a television along the north wall, and striking the north wall. Mr. Young advised the television had been moved prior to my arrival but was in approximately the same location as when the incident occurred.

PPO D. Rose advised the gold Chrysler Town & Country Minivan (WA license BXU4297) located in front of the residence had been struck, indicating a suspected bullet hole in the windshield (**ER/A1**), the interior having been covered with duct tape prior to my arrival, and the front passenger side window, which had been covered with plastic prior to my arrival.

PPO D. Rose indicate two more vehicles with suspected ballistic damage parked in front of 3501 S Asotin St: a silver Chevrolet Colorado (WA license C34475N) with three suspected bullet holes (**ERs/A1-2, B1, C1**), and a silver Honda CR-V (WA license BSK7274) with one suspected bullet hole (**ER/A1**).

I visually searched the northwest yard of 3501 S Asotin St for the spent bullet that passed through the silver Honda CR-V (WA license BSK7274) with negative results.

Lastly, PPO D. Rose advised he had located approximately twenty-two (22) cartridge casings; twelve (12) in the driveway to 3502 S Asotin St (**EMs/1-12**) and ten (10) in the roadway of S Asotin St (**EMs/13-22**). Upon closer inspection of the scene, no additional cartridge casings were located.

I was then contacted by PPO D. Walsh via radio who advised a second residence, located at 1627 S 35th St, had also been struck during the incident. PPO D. Walsh stated the residence was struck three times. I contacted the resident at this address, Jennifer Chernut, who showed me the areas of suspected ballistic damage. Ms. Chernut stated that after speaking with PPO D. Walsh earlier, she discovered a spent bullet, which she had not touched, at the base of the second-floor staircase as well as damage to the staircase's ceiling.

I observed three (3) suspected bullet holes to the south facing exterior of the residence; one (1) through the siding above the south facing entry door, one (1) through the white trim above the large picture window located east of the entry door, and one (1) through the gutter downspout between the window and door. I observed the spent bullet and damaged staircase ceiling but could not locate an exterior bullet hole.

I sent a link to Jennifer Chernut via text message at (253) 273-2404 to allow her to upload files to the Tacoma Police Department's Digital Evidence Management System (DEMS). I reviewed and accepted two (2) assets to the case file.

While photographing the scene, I was contacted by CST K. Bendlin, who had finished photographing the motor vehicle accident scene. I advised CST K. Bendlin that the residences located at 1627 and 1631 S 35th St were struck during the incident and still need photographed. I showed her the suspected ballistic damage to each residence, relaying my observations.

While photographing the silver Chevrolet Colorado (WA BXU4297) and silver Honda CR-V (WA license BSK7274) I was contacted by the vehicles' owners, Jenna and Jonathan Winskie. I advised them to have the bullets collected if they are located during repairs and to turn them in at TPD Headquarters as evidence.

I took the above listed photographs with Sgt. D. Myhre, PPO D. Rose, PPO T. Trott, and CST K. Bendlin on scene.

The collected evidence items, **EMs/1-22**, were transported to the Forensics Laboratory to be inventoried then submitted to the Pierce County Property Room.

Narrative:

On Friday, May 06, 2022, at the request of Sergeant D. Myhre, I responded with CST J. Sodon to the above location to document a drive-by shooting. Upon arrival, Sergeant Myhre provided us with a briefing on the incident, and we then divided the scene between us to expedite processing. I made contact with Officer J. Correa who advised a victim (Checkzie Sidibe) had been struck three (3) times in the right leg while driving his vehicle northbound on S. Asotin Street before losing control and rolling his vehicle up against a utility pole at the intersection of S. 35th Street and S. Ainsworth Avenue. I was further advised that the victim exited the vehicle and ran to the front stoop of the residence at 1611 S. 35th Street where Emergency Medical personnel began to treat his injuries. After conducting a walk-through of the scene, the above listed photographs were captured.

Items of the victim's clothing were observed in the roadway in front of, as well as on the front stoop of the residence at 1611 S. 35th Street. The items were marked with Evidence Markers (EMs #01-05) and were collected as evidence.

The victim's vehicle, a silver Mazda 3 (WA CBF1720), was observed to be resting on its hood and roof and was in contact with a utility pole at the intersection of S. 35th Street and S. Ainsworth Avenue. Two (2) suspected bullet holes were observed in the front passenger-side door (marked A1 and B1). After the tow truck righted the vehicle and removed it from the pole, a second white, New Balance sneaker was observed on the grass near where the vehicle had been located (EM #06). Holes that appeared to correspond with the damage marked on the outside of the vehicle were observed on the interior of the front passenger-side door. It should be noted that we did not have consent nor a warrant to enter the vehicle, so all interior photographs were captured from outside the vehicle.

At the request of Officer J. Levitt, I sent a link to Kania Wiley via text message at 719-639-8839 to allow her to upload files to the Tacoma Police Department's Digital Evidence Management System (DEMS). I reviewed and accepted three (3) assets to the case file.

I then made contact with CST Sodon to assist her with any remaining scene processing. She advised that two (2) residences had been struck and walked me through where the damage was located.

I responded to 1627 S. 35th Street and made contact with the resident, Jennifer Chernut. Four (4) suspected bullet holes were observed in the front of the residence and were marked A1, B1, and B2. It should be noted that the last hole, which was located in the top of the front window frame, could not be labeled due to its height. Ms. Chernut then showed me the damage to the inside of her residence. Inside, I observed that there was no damage to the front wall corresponding with the holes observed in the exterior. One (1) suspected bullet hole was observed in the ceiling above the staircase along the

west side of the residence, and one (1) suspected projectile was observed on the floor at the base of the staircase (EM #07).

I then responded to 1631 S. 35th Street and made contact with a resident, Richard Young. Two (2) bullet holes were observed in the exterior of the residence and were labeled A1 and B1. Inside, corresponding damage was observed above the front door (labeled A2) and in a bedroom located in an extension off the west side of the residence (B2-B5). Mr. Young advised that a pipe located in a header above the doorway to the kitchen had been damaged during the incident causing a water leak. At the time of my arrival, repairs had already begun and a section of the header that had been damaged had already been removed. I was able to look into the header and observed a suspected bullet defect on the back wall. Mr. Young then showed me a piece of pipe with suspected bullet damage that had been removed during the repair.

The collected evidence items marked EMs #01-07 were transported to the secured Forensics Laboratory. The items marked EMs #01-06 were placed in the BioDry Room to air dry before future processing and submission to the Pierce County Property Room.

CST J. Sodon and Officers J. Correa and T. Trott were the primary units on scene with me during processing.

They HAVE TO REVIEW AND APPROVE TOO!

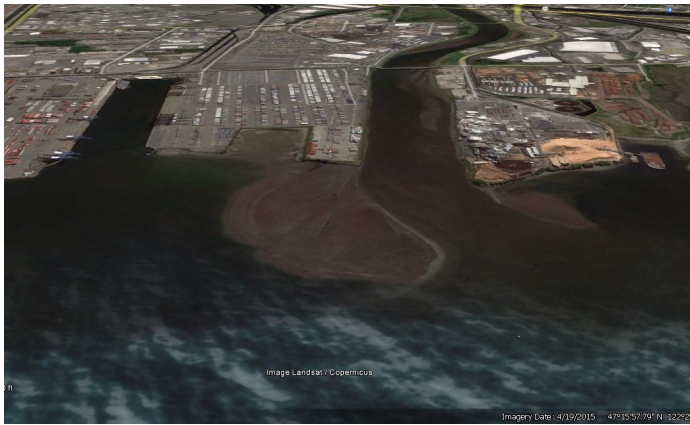

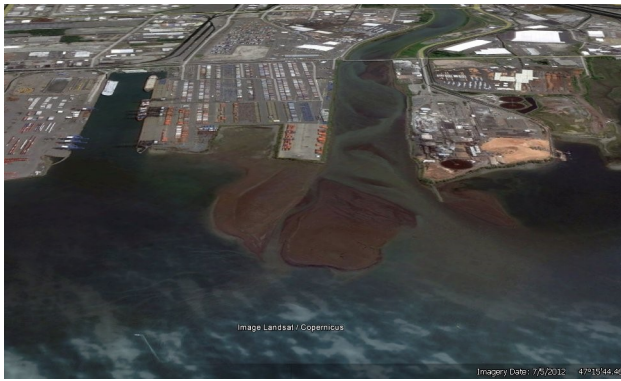
Get busy and work with the federal government and state government. I've already brought things to the attention of Laurie Jenkins and I am including her here too.

Ecology, EPA now under the gun to adopt new water quality criteria for aquatic creatures

Long delays in updating state water-quality standards to protect orcas, fish and other aquatic species appear to have finally caught up with the Washington Department of Ecology and its federal counterpart, the Environmental Protection Agency.

In a court ruling this week, **U.S. District Judge Marsha Pechman of Seattle found that Ecology has “abdicated its duties” to update certain water-quality standards, as required by the federal Clean Water Act.** Meanwhile, she said, **EPA has failed to meet its legal oversight obligations to ensure that adequate water-quality standards are protective of aquatic creatures.**

The lawsuit, brought by Northwest Environmental Advocates, followed a petition filed by the group in 2013 seeking to get EPA to revise Washington’s water quality standards for aquatic species. **The petition followed years of delay by the state.** The standards, including numeric aquatic life criteria, place limits on toxic chemicals found in the state’s waterways. It took four years, but **EPA eventually denied the petition, refusing to make a determination about whether or not the state’s existing water quality standards were consistent with the Clean Water Act.**

In its denial and later court pleadings, EPA stressed its desire to support Ecology’s efforts to update aquatic life criteria. **Ecology** had discussed the update and even proposed it as part of the agency’s **2015-2020 strategic plan, but the work was never started.** EPA admitted that **Washington’s aquatic life criteria had not been updated for most chemicals since 1992,** even though formal reviews and updates are required every three years, noted Judge Pechman in her ruling.

The judge’s order, (<https://www.pugetsoundinstitute.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/12/Order.pdf>) issued Wednesday, requires EPA to determine **within 180 days if the state’s current water quality standards are consistent with the Clean Water Act** or if they need to be revised. If they are determined to be inadequate, **the act itself requires EPA to promptly promulgate new regulations** — unless the state adopts acceptable standards in the meantime.

Ecology officials acknowledge that the agency has been slow to adopt new aquatic life criteria. *In fact, the required three-year “triennial review” has not been conducted since 2010.* Ecology currently is going through a new triennial review, and the agency’s draft work plan lists the update to aquatic life criteria as a priority over the next four years.

“We have not conducted a triennial review since 2010 because we were in continual rulemaking efforts for the water quality standards,” states the introduction to the draft work plan (PDF 494 kb).

No doubt Ecology dedicated a lot of time and effort to other water-quality rules the past decade. Much public attention — including a legislative battle — was focused on human exposures to toxic chemicals, as Ecology worked through the long development of new human health criteria. The discussions largely revolved around fish-consumption rates for people who eat a lot of fish, along with what was considered an allowable cancer risk.

In a controversial move after Ecology completed its work, **EPA refused to accept some of the state’s human health criteria, imposing stronger restrictions than Ecology proposed.** The criteria were **later reversed by President Trump’s EPA.** Even today, the issue is not yet resolved, with a revised rule in the works from EPA in the midst of a lawsuit. (<https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Laws-rules-rulemaking/Closed-rulemaking/WAC-173-201A-Overview>)) I have been following these issues since their inception in 2010, including a 2015 article in the Kitsap Sun (<https://archive.kitsapsun.com/news/local/feds-watch-closely-as-state-updates-water-quality-standards-ep-978184867-354869921.html>) newspaper.

Some of the rule-making that Ecology says contributed to delays:

- * Recreational use criteria (<https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Laws-rules-rulemaking/Closed-rulemaking/WAC-173-201A-Aug17>)
- * Total dissolved gas (<https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Laws-rules-rulemaking/Closed-rulemaking/WAC173-201A-revisions>)
- * Salmon spawning habitat, and (<https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Laws-rules-rulemaking/Rulemaking/WAC173-201A-Salmon-spawning-habitat>)
- * Chelan River use attainability analysis (<https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Laws-rules-rulemaking/Rulemaking/WAC173-201A-Chelan-UAA>)

Since EPA is in charge of enforcing the provisions of the Clean Water Act, Judge Pechman focused her attention on EPA’s failure to take charge of the situation, other than to encourage Ecology to get moving on the aquatic life criteria:

“The CWA (Clean Water Act) operates on a principle of cooperative federalism where states take the lead in setting WQS (water quality standards) with the goal of eliminating pollutant discharge into navigable waters to protect and enhance human and aquatic life,” the judge wrote in her order (PDF 228 kb). (<https://www.pugetsoundinstitute.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/12/Order.pdf>) “States must create WQS specific to aquatic life and review them every three years to determine whether new or revised standards are necessary.

“But while states play a lead role in setting WQS, EPA serves as a backstop,” she continued. “Not only does EPA have to review state-adopted WQS, but it must also ‘promptly prepare and publish’ new WQS for a state ‘in any case where the administrator determines that a revised or new standard is necessary to meet the requirements of this chapter.’...

“So while EPA wanted to **‘work in partnership to efficiently and effectively allocate resources to address pollution and accelerate state adoption of new and revised criteria,’ nothing in the record showed that Washington was a willing partner.** And certainly nothing in the record supports EPA’s belief that inaction would be an efficient or effective way of ensuring adequate WQS or complying with the goals and requirements of the CWA.”

The judge calls out specific criteria that EPA has recommended for updates, based on scientific studies, including aquatic life criteria for **ammonia and copper**. She did not accept EPA’s excuse that Ecology may have higher priorities or that EPA lacks the resources to undertake the rulemaking.

“This wait-and-see approach appears particularly ill-conceived in light of EPA’s recognition that **copper pollution has an ‘adverse impact on salmonids,’** whose health impacts ‘critically important and endangered species throughout the Pacific Northwest,’” she stated.

Pechman noted that **the letter denying the petition for rule-making contains no explanation about how EPA was “marshaling its limited resources to protect Washington’s waters or why simply waiting for Washington to act would be reasonable to meet the CWA’s goals. This undermines EPA’s position.”**

The judge also rejected EPA’s argument that the update to Washington’s human health criteria — a related set of standards — would protect aquatic life. She cited EPA’s own recommendations for **copper**, which are 1,200 micrograms per liter for humans but a maximum of 4.8 micrograms per liter for aquatic life. *Under those recommendations, what is considered safe for humans is 250 times higher than what is considered safe for protecting salmon from acute toxicity. (Chronic levels are considered even lower for aquatic life.)*

Further, the judge points out, EPA should not assume that its national recommendations would be adequate for the unique species of Washington state — “such as **Puget Sound’s Southern Resident Orcas who are some of the most contaminated marine mammals in the world** due to bioaccumulation through the food stock, particularly through Chinook salmon.”

The judge ordered EPA to make a determination on the adequacy of the state’s aquatic life criteria within 180 days, but she agreed to allow additional time if EPA can provide “specific, detailed explanations of why additional time is necessary and what tasks remain to be performed.”

How that will mesh with Ecology’s time schedule is yet to be seen. Most relevant staffers with Ecology as well as EPA were out this week for the holiday. I will invite them to contribute comments, concerns and additional context when they return.

Ecology’s draft work plan covering the next four years does not lay out a specific timetable for adopting aquatic life criteria. The agency has taken comments on four possible approaches to adopting new water quality standards:

- * Option 1: Stagger three rule-making by group (metals, organics, non-priority)
- * Option 2: Stagger two rule-making by group (all metals, all organics)
- * Option 3: Rule-makings for different groups of chemicals based on highest priority
- * Option 4: Review and update all necessary criteria in one rule-making

In bringing its lawsuit, Northwest Environmental Advocates said Washington state has revised aquatic life criteria for some toxic chemicals since 1992, but many remain less protective than EPA's recommended levels. For 14 chemicals, Washington has no aquatic life criteria at all, whereas EPA has established maximum levels in freshwater to avoid acute or chronic toxicity, according to NWEA. In saltwater, Washington has no criteria for 11 chemicals for which EPA provides recommended standards, the group says.

Under the Endangered Species Act, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service have reviewed the adequacy of aquatic life criteria for the states of California, Oregon and Idaho. (USFWS covers freshwater species, while NMFS covers saltwater species.) For a number of chemicals, the agencies have found that criteria adopted by the states and approved by EPA are likely to jeopardize the continued existence of a threatened or endangered species, the so-called "jeopardy" finding.

To show that Washington's standards are outdated, NWEA **listed more than two dozen chemicals for which the state uses numeric criteria that are either higher or close to the levels found to be in violation of the Endangered Species Act.**

"Levels of these and other toxic pollutants are among the reasons that EPA has long been concerned about the health of one of Washington's most important waterbodies, Puget Sound," states the legal complaint (PDF 490 kb).
