- The elimination of discrimination based on race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, marital status, familial status, disability, or military status;
- Access to justice, food, shelter, clothing, healthcare, education, or transportation;
- Reduction in violence, including domestic violence, and other crimes;
- Increased job opportunities through training or job creation;
- Reduction in adverse environmental impacts on our community;
- Safety and well being; or
- Human dignity.
