Ken Monner's term on the Police Officers' Pension/Disability Board will expire June 30, 2023.

Nomination forms were mailed April 27, 2023, to the homes of all LEOFF 1 retired members of the Police Department. Nomination forms must be received by May 16, 2023.

Nominees must be willing to serve on the Board for a period of three (3) years. There are no term limits; therefore, Board members may serve consecutive terms if elected.

LEOFF 1 or LEOFF 2 active and retired members of the Police Department may be nominated to serve on the Board. Only LEOFF 1 active and retired members may nominate and vote in the election process.

Nominations will continue to be accepted until the May 16, 2023, deadline.

Per Board policy, balloting will not be held in the event of only one nominee.

UPDATE as of 5/25/2023

The current Police Officers' Board nomination process closed as of May 16, 2023.

The Police Pension Office received nomination forms with nine signatures nominating the current Board incumbent Ken Monner, retired LEOFF 1 member.

Per Board policy, balloting will not be held in the event of only one nominee. Therefore, no ballots will be mailed and Ken Monner is declared elected for the three-year term beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2026.
