Exit Interview - Washington State Auditor

Audit Lead Debra Burleson, of the Washington State Auditor's Office (WSAO), presented the Exit Conference for the 2014 Tacoma Employees' Retirement System's audit. The Washington State Auditor's Office Exit Conference report, dated June 18, 2015, was distributed to the Retirement Board in the Board Packet prior to the meeting.

It was noted in the Independent Auditor's Report, dated June 16, 2015, that the Tacoma Employees' Retirement System had received an unmodified audit opinion for calendar year 2014. There were no audit recommendations.
