Call to Order:

Board Member Heller shared that she had been contacted by a constituent in November regarding an incident that occurred with a Meter Reader on November 15, 2018 in Southeast Tacoma. She requested a full, fair and thorough investigation of this incident of animal abuse and requested a report back to the Civil Service Board with the results of this investigation. Board Member Heller described the incident as a dog in a fenced yard that was sprayed with pepper spray by a Meter Reader adding that the Meter Reader did not need to enter the yard in order to read the meter.

Board Member Hansen asked if Alice Phillips had been informed of the study session next month. Ms. Hobson advised that Alice does receive the meeting agendas in advance and that Roberta Burnett was in the audience this evening as well. Board Member Hanson also asked if HR planned to bring job descriptions to the February study session.
