1. Call to Order; Roll Call

Chair Cooks

Lisa Jaret introduced Rico Lastrapes, the new Tacoma Creates Program Technician to TCAB. He then shared a little bit about himself.

Clarissa Gines provided updates on the 2022-23 Tacoma Creates application workshops and support, and announced a new capacity building opportunity that is being offered to currently funded organizations around data collection, management, and analysis.

Lisa Jaret then shared information on Inspire Olympia, which is a cultural access initiative that will be on the City of Olympia’s ballot at the end of April.

6. TCAB Engagement/Operations

Chair Cooks briefly shared some committee and panel updates, as well as information on an opportunity for TCAB members to engage in a technical working group with funded organizations.

She also shared that the Advisory Board page on the Tacoma Creates website is in the process of being updated, and Rico Lastrapes provided a sneak peek of the updated page.

7. Presentation: School’s Out Washington

Sergio Beltran & Ka’ohe Wong

Lisa Jaret introduced Sergio Beltran, Program Quality Manager for School’s Out Washington, and Ka’ohe Wong, Division Director for Program Quality. They presented information on the importance of professional learning, program quality improvement, and how this ultimately impacts young people.

Chair Cooks facilitated questions after the presentation.

8. Presentation: Participatory Budgeting

Victor Rodriguez

Lisa Jaret introduced Victor Rodriguez, Health Equity Manager with the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department’s Center for Excellence. He shared information on the public launch of the voting process for the Tacoma Creates Participatory Budgeting project.

9. OACV Staff Reports

Naomi Strom-Avila

Naomi Strom-Avila provided information on a Neighborhood Planning Program pilot project, which looks at neighborhood history and identity. There is an upcoming meeting, which is currently focused on the McKinley neighborhood.

10. Closing Comments

Chair Cooks, TCAB Members

Chair Cooks gave Tony Hudson the opportunity to participate in the TCAB member spotlight, since he was unable to earlier in the meeting. Lisa Jaret shared a comment from Allison Campbell about her participation in the Destiny City Film Festival, and Naomi O’Connor reported out on her attendance at the Asia Pacific Cultural Center’s New Year’s Celebration.

As a future agenda item, Roxane Hreha asked if there could be discussion on the legislation that guides Tacoma Creates’ work.
