1. Call to Order; Roll Call

Chair Cooks

Chair Cooks provided an opportunity for attendees to share public comment. Kay Clemons with Entertainment Resource Alliance shared a comment that was recorded.

5. Program Updates

Staff

Clarissa Gines gave an update on the upcoming funding year and invited TCAB members to the Kick-Off Convening happening later in the month.

Lisa Jaret then shared some Office of Arts & Cultural Vitality staffing transitions and invited Amy McBride to speak; Amy shared her retirement plans. Lisa Jaret wrapped up with some general updates around communications and community engagement events.

6. TCAB Committees & Operations

Chair Cooks

Chair Cooks shared the list of TCAB committees, and the members who sit on each of those committees.

First, Chair Cooks, TCAB member Allison Campbell, and Lisa Jaret shared some updates related to the process for reauthorization of Tacoma Creates. Vice Chair Robinson represented the Operations Committee and shared that he will be meeting with TCAB member Amanda Figueroa soon. Lisa Jaret reported that the Recruitment Committee did not meet last month, but staff will follow up soon on next steps. TCAB members Allison Campbell and Katie Mattran met last month for an Annual Report committee and shared that they had an initial conversation on report timeline, and they will be meeting soon.

Clarissa Gines and TCAB member Megan Clark then shared their experience attending the Mayor’s Youth Commission meeting last month.

Lisa Jaret introduced the following items for discussion at the meeting: BIPOC leadership stats at Tacoma Creates-funded organizations, capacity building for individual organizations, listening sessions, organization presentations, and tabling opportunities. Lots of good feedback and questions were shared regarding these discussion items, and many TCAB members volunteered to sit on various committees.

8. OACV Staff Reports

Clarissa Gines provided information on calls to artists for the Tacoma Studio Tour, Arts at the Armory, and concrete stamps. She also shared news that OACV was the recent recipient of a National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) “Our Town” grant to support creative placemaking in the McKinley neighborhood.

Chair Cooks offered space for TCAB members to share any experiences they had with events put on by Tacoma Creates-supported organizations. TCAB member Allison Campbell, and Lisa Jaret shared updates from programs they’ve attended in the last month.

Chair Cooks reminded TCAB members to check out the Tacoma Creates events calendar, and that they are welcome to share ideas for future agenda items with staff.
