WHAT IS BEING CONSIDERED?

The City Council is considering revisions to the City's billboard regulations which would prohibit digital billboards, based upon a recommendation from the Tacoma Planning Commission. In addition, the recommended revisions modify certain definitions, change uses and zones buffered from billboards, and change the way nonconforming billboards are addressed.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING?

The City Council is seeking public comment on these potential code changes prior to acting on the amendments. You received this notice because you or a group you belong to has been identified as a potentially interested party.
