Guidelines

- The **estimated** maximum award amount will be \$915,544 for 14 months.
- Solicitations are coordinated by City of Tacoma
 Purchasing staff and posted on the Purchasing website.
- Responses to Proposal may not exceed 5 pages total (one-sided).
- Appeals to a Request for Proposal (RFP) are limited to consideration of alleged defects relating to solicitation and/or evaluation processes. Appeals to the actual award recommendation are not allowed.

Project Overview

Since 2015 the City has invested in services to operate a day center and shelter to support services to reduce barriers for young adults who are experiencing homelessness. The Beacon Activity Center is a multi-generational center located at 415 South 13th Street, Tacoma, Washington 98402. During the day (7 am – 9 pm) the Young Adult Drop-in Center serves up to 50 individuals daily, while the Senior Center is operating. During the evening (9 pm – 7 am), the Young Adult Overnight Shelter serves up to 50 individuals, and an additional 20 individuals during inclement weather. The target population is City of Tacoma residents only with this funding between the ages of 18-24 for both the day and evening services.

Services should include (but are not limited to):

- The implementation of a Community Advisory Committee to contribute community voice to engage individuals in issues important to them, and gain insights of the concerns of the participants of the center.
- Assist young adults experiencing homelessness obtain and maintain permanent housing by addressing barriers to housing.
- Provide meals, and life skills training to young adults' experiencing homelessness participating in the program.
- Maintain a safe environment thriving environment.
