

**AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF PIERCE COUNTY
TOURISM PROMOTION AREA**

THIS AMENDMENT dated this 25 day of May, 2011, is made and entered into by and among PIERCE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, the CITY OF TACOMA, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; the CITY OF PUYALLUP, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; the CITY OF FIFE, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; the CITY OF GIG HARBOR, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; the CITY OF LAKEWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; the CITY OF DUPONT, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; and the CITY OF SUMNER, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington, ("Parties") and amends and attaches to and is part of the existing Interlocal Agreement entered into between the Parties.

RECITALS

1. The Pierce County Council, through Resolution R2009-119, authorized the County Executive to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the cities of DuPont, Fife, Gig Harbor, Lakewood, Puyallup, Sumner and Tacoma for the establishment of a Pierce County Tourism Promotion Area pursuant to RCW 35.101.

2. The Parties have by appropriate legislative action executed an Interlocal Agreement for the Establishment of Pierce County Tourism Promotion Area ("TPA Agreement") to levy special assessments to fund tourism promotion. The Pierce County contract number for the TPA Agreement is 077381-0.

3. The Pierce County Council, through Ordinance 2009-110s, created the Pierce County Tourism Promotion Area to levy special assessments to fund tourism promotion.

4. The parties agree that there is ambiguity in the phrase "and are not intended to supplant existing funding" in Section 7, paragraph E of the TPA Agreement and that this phrase has unintended fund distribution, accounting and auditing consequences.

5. To resolve the ambiguity of this phrase and its unintended consequences, the parties desire to amend the TPA Agreement to clarify the parties' agreement of the management of funds derived from the TPA special assessment.





13 **Whereas**, the State of Washington by Revised Code of Washington (RCW)
14 39.34 and RCW 35.101 authorized counties to establish Tourism Promotion Areas to
15 permit the levy of Special Assessments for tourism promotion; and

17 **Whereas**, the Pierce County Council authorized the establishment of a Tourism
18 Promotion Area within Pierce County by Ordinance No. 2009-110s; and

20 **Whereas**, Pierce County entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the cities of
21 Tacoma, Puyallup, Fife, Gig Harbor, Lakewood, DuPont, and Sumner, to administer the
22 Tourism Promotion Area, and assigned its administrative responsibility to the Economic
23 Development Division; and

25 **Whereas**, the Economic Development Division has requested an amendment to
26 the Interlocal Agreement to make the administration of the Tourism Promotion Area
27 funds more manageable; and

29 **Whereas**, the Economic Development Division recommends that the following
30 words be deleted in the Interlocal Agreement, "and are not intended to supplant existing
31 funding" (Section 7, paragraph E); **Now Therefore**,
