1 A RESOLUTION relating to the vacation of City right-of-way; setting Thursday,
 2 October 20, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., as the date for a hearing before the City
 3 of Tacoma Hearing Examiner on the petition of St. Nicholas Greek
 4 Orthodox Church to vacate the easterly eight feet of Yakima Avenue
 South, lying between South 15th and South 16th Streets, to facilitate
 and accommodate existing and future building improvements.

5 WHEREAS St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, having received the
 6 consent of the owners of more than two-thirds of the properties abutting the
 7 easterly eight feet of Yakima Avenue South, lying between South 15th and
 8 South 16th Streets, has petitioned for the vacation of the following legally
 9 described right-of-way area:

11 The easterly 8 feet of South Yakima Avenue abutting Lots 1
 12 through 12, inclusive, Block 1515 of Map of New Tacoma,
 13 Washington Territory, according to the plat thereof recorded
 February 3, 1875, Records of Pierce County, Washington;

 17 fixed as the date and time, and the Council Chambers on the first floor of the
 18 Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, in the City of Tacoma, as the
 19 place when and where said request will be heard by the Hearing Examiner
 20 and her recommendations thereafter transmitted to the Council of the City of
 21 Tacoma.

RESOLUTION NO. 39538

1 A RESOLUTION relating to the prevention of domestic violence; authorizing the
2 execution of an agreement with the Crystal Judson Family Justice
3 Center ("FJC") in the amount of \$400,000, budgeted from the General Fund
4 and Mental Health Fund, to assist in funding essential expenditures and
5 other costs of the FJC for the period of January 1, 2016, through
6 December 31, 2016.

7 WHEREAS, in 2005, the Crystal Judson Family Justice Center ("FJC") was
8 created as a partnership between Pierce County and the City of Tacoma,
9 dedicated to the prevention of domestic violence, and

10 WHEREAS the City and Pierce County have agreed to ensure adequate
11 funding for FJC essential expenditures and functions, which consist of lease costs
12 for the facility and salaries of the executive officers, and

13 WHEREAS, for 2016, the City's portion of the FJC essential expenditures
14 and functions, as well as other FJC costs, is \$400,000, and

15 WHEREAS funding is available from the General Fund and Mental Health
16 Fund for these costs; Now, Therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

18 That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an
19 agreement with the Crystal Judson Family Justice Center ("FJC"), in the amount of
20 \$400,000, budgeted from the General Fund and Mental Health Fund, for essential
21 expenditures and other costs of the FJC for the period of January 1, 2016, through
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1 December 31, 2016, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed
2 agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
