The Tacoma City Council, at its regular City Council meeting of April 30, 2019, adopted the following resolutions and/or ordinances. 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### **Resolution No. 40312**

A resolution awarding a contract to Active Construction Inc., in the amount of \$1,476,476.00, plus applicable taxes, plus a 20 percent contingency, for drainage and traffic safety improvements at the Solid Waste Management facility, plus bid alternative work of \$55,000.00, for in-pavement flashing lights and pedestrian crossing flashers, for a total of \$1,837,771.20, budgeted from the Solid Waste Fund - Specification No. ES19-0026F.

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## RESOLUTION NO. 40318

1 A RESOLUTION relating to public safety and human services; ratifying the  
2 2018 agreement with Pierce County Department of Assigned Counsel, in the  
3 amount of \$2,015,699, retroactive for the period of January 1, 2018, through  
4 December 31, 2018; and the 2019 agreement with Pierce County  
5 Department of Assigned Counsel in the amount of \$2,052,009, retroactive to  
6 January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019, budgeted from the General  
7 Fund, to provide legal services for indigent defendants appearing in Tacoma  
8 Municipal Court.

9 WHEREAS individuals accused of a crime have a right to legal  
10 representation, which is guaranteed by the constitutions of the United States and  
11 the state of Washington, and

12 WHEREAS it is the obligation of the public to bear the cost of such legal  
13 defense for accused individuals who are determined by the court to be indigent, and

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 35979, adopted on October, 14,  
15 2003, the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the Pierce County  
16 Department of Assigned Counsel ("DAC"), for the provision of said services, which  
17 agreement has been renewed on a yearly basis since 2003, and

18 WHEREAS DAC has provided, and is able to continue providing, valuable  
19 legal services that are necessary to the proper disposition of misdemeanor cases  
20 heard in Tacoma Municipal Court, and

21 WHEREAS, in addition to the services rendered by DAC, data is regularly  
22 provided to the City's Office of Management and Budget in order to evaluate the  
23 performance of the agreement, including, but not limited to, caseload per attorney,  
24 types of cases handled by DAC, and outcomes, and

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WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the City to enter into the proposed agreements with DAC, in the amount of \$2,015,699, retroactive for the period of January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018; and in the amount of \$2,052,009, retroactive to January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019, budgeted from the General Fund, for the purpose of providing legal services for indigent defendants appearing in Tacoma Municipal Court; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Pierce County Department of Assigned Counsel ("DAC") in the amount of \$2,015,699, retroactive for the period of January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018, for the purpose of providing legal services for indigent defendants appearing in Tacoma Municipal Court, as on file in the office of the City Clerk, and further, that the actions by City officials to implement said agreement are hereby ratified.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with DAC in the amount of \$2,052,009, retroactive to January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019, budgeted from the General Fund, for the purpose of providing legal services for indigent defendants appearing in



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Tacoma Municipal Court, as on file in the office of the City Clerk, and further, that the actions by City officials to implement said agreement are hereby ratified.
