RESOLUTION NO. 40579

1 A RESOLUTION amending Resolution No. 40570, relating to the Tideflats
2 Interim Regulations public hearing, to change the public hearing date
3 to Tuesday, May 5, 2020 upon completion of Regular Agenda Items,
4 no earlier than 5:15 p.m.

4 WHEREAS on May 9, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution
5 No. 39723, initiating a subarea planning process for the Port of Tacoma/Tideflats
6 (“Tideflats”) area, which additionally requested the Planning Commission
7 (“Commission”) to consider the need for interim regulations in the Tideflats area
8 while the subarea planning process is under way, and
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10 WHEREAS the Commission determined the interim regulations were
11 warranted, and forwarded its recommendation to the City Council for
12 consideration on October 4, 2017, and
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14 WHEREAS in support of these deliberations, the Commission conducted a
15 public hearing at which 81 people testified, and reviewed over 200 written
16 comments, and
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18 WHEREAS, following its own public hearing with substantial community
19 input and deliberation, the City Council adopted the interim regulations on
20 November 21, 2017, by Amended Ordinance No. 28470, which includes the
21 following elements:

- 22 • Category 1: Expanded public notification of heavy industrial use
23 permits;
- 24 • Category 2: Temporary prohibition of new non-industrial uses in
25 the Port of Tacoma Manufacturing and Industrial Center;
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- Category 3: Temporary prohibition of new residential development along Marine View Drive and northeast Tacoma slopes; and
- Category 4: Temporary prohibition on certain types of new heavy industrial uses.

WHEREAS following another public hearing, which included substantial community input and deliberation, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 28542 on November 13, 2018, which extended the interim regulations for another six months, and

WHEREAS following another public hearing, which included substantial community input and deliberation, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 28583 on May 21, 2019, which extended the interim regulations for another six months, with an expiration date of December 2, 2019, and

WHEREAS following another public hearing, which included substantial community input and deliberation, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 28619 on November 12, 2019, which extended the interim regulations for another six months, with a current expiration date of May 2, 2020; Now, Therefore,



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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Tuesday, May 5, 2020, upon completion of the Regular Agenda items, no earlier than 5:15 p.m., is hereby fixed as the time and date, for a public hearing to be held on the potential reauthorization and extension of the Tideflats Interim Regulations, in a manner and forum to be published on the City of Tacoma's website, and which is compliant with the Proclamation 20-28 issued by Governor Jay Inslee on March 24, 2020, which prohibits in-person meetings and temporarily suspends portions of the State Open Public Meetings Act.

Section 2. That the City Council finds that this Resolution is necessary, routine, and consistent with Governor Inslee's emergency proclamation issued March 24, 2020, suspending portions of the Open Public Meetings Act for 30 days.

4 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective
5 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and
6 the administration, and

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8 WHEREAS Resolution No. 39935, adopted February 6, 2018, authorized the
9 execution of the four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement (“CBA”) between the
10 City of Tacoma and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483,
11 Tacoma Power Unit (“Union”), on behalf of the employees represented by said
12 Union, and

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14 WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement
15 (“LOA”) to the CBA which provides for the following: (1) the creation of a new
16 classification to be titled Electrician, Lead (CSC 5237), which will be classified,
17 overtime category C, and have a one-step, hourly rate of \$45.88, set at ten percent
18 above the current rate of pay of the Electrician (CSC 5236) classification; (2) the
19 elimination of Step 1 of the pay scale of the current Heating/AC Maintenance
20 Mechanic Supervisor (CSC 5145) classification, due to compression and for
21 clarification; and (3) amendments to Article 9.1 of the collective bargaining
22 agreement to clarify how temporary upgrades will be offered and how upgraded
23 employees will be compensated, and
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WHEREAS the LOA was considered and approved by the Public Utility Board at its special meeting of March 31, 2020, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Tacoma Power Unit, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.

18 Board at its special meeting of March 31, 2020, and

19 WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated
20 by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Tacoma Power Unit, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
