

RECYCLE RIGHT AT YOUR PROPERTY

You are the key to the success of your recycling program. Help your residents recycle right by encouraging them to follow these simple rules:

▶ RECYCLABLES SHOULD BE:



Empty



Clean



Dry



NO PLASTIC BAGS

Residents should not bag their recyclables, or recycle their plastic bags. All bagged items and plastic bags are garbage.



YES

These items are accepted for curbside recycling in Tacoma:

Metal Cans



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, & Tubs



Paper



Cardboard



NO

These items are **not** accepted for curbside recycling in Tacoma:

Food & Greasy Paper



Plastic Bags & Styrofoam



Plastic Clamshells



Single Use Cups, Utensils & Straws

SOLID WASTE RESOURCES FOR YOUR PROPERTY AND RESIDENTS

- ▶ 3-1-1** Call 3-1-1 (within city limits) or (253) 591-5000, to answer general questions about the City of Tacoma government and services. Staff are available from 8AM-4:30PM, Monday through Friday. You can also visit them at cityoftacoma.org/tacomafirst311.
- ▶ Call-2-Haul** Schedule a pickup of large bulky items by contacting our Call-2-Haul program at (253) 573-2468. Up to three large items, and/or 15 boxes or bags of small items can be collected per pickup. For a list of accepted items and fees, visit cityoftacoma.org/call2haul. Fees are added to your utility account.
- ▶ EnviroHouse** The EnviroHouse is a model home showcasing green building and natural landscape ideas, materials and techniques to create a healthy home and planet. Your residents can visit the EnviroHouse for free workshops on sustainable gardening, cleaning, and living. - ▶ FoodCycling** Turn your resident's food waste into compost by adding our FoodCycling service. It's easy to set up! Learn more at cityoftacoma.org/foodcycling or call (253) 502-2100.
- ▶ Household Hazardous Waste** Residents can dispose of their household hazardous waste (like batteries, light bulbs, and household cleaners) at the Household Hazardous Waste Center on 3510 S. Mullen St. Call (253) 591-5418 or visit cityoftacoma.org/hazwaste to learn more.
- ▶ Recycle Center** The Recycle Center at 3510 S. Mullen St. offers free, drop-off recycling. Tacoma and Pierce County residents can drop off their recyclables seven days a week, 8AM-6PM.
