Wage theft is the illegal withholding of wages or the denial of benefits that are owed to an employee. It is governed by the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) and can include such things as:

- ◆ Failure to pay minimum wage or prevailing wage
- ◆ Improper withholding of wages
- ◆ Failure to compensate for overtime
- ◆ Improper classification of employees
- ◆ Failure to make proper deductions
