



RESOLUTION NO. 39194

1 BY REQUEST OF MAYOR STRICKLAND

2 A RESOLUTION relating to committees, boards, and commissions; increasing
3 the number of the Tacoma Minimum Wage Task Force ("Task Force")
4 members from 13 to 15 by adding two additional members representing
5 business and citizen groups, and adding two alternates; and appointing
6 individuals to the Task Force.

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 39187, adopted May 5, 2015, the
8 Tacoma Minimum Wage Task Force ("Task Force") was created to establish a
9 committee to convene and discuss alternatives to the 15 Now Initiative and
10 provide recommendations to the City Council by June 30, 2015, and

11 WHEREAS the Resolution created a 13-member task force, with each
12 Council Member nominating a City resident, preferably from their District, where
13 applicable, for consideration to the Task Force, said nominees to be
14 geographically and culturally diverse to represent the entire Tacoma community,
15 and four members representing various business and citizen groups, to be
16 selected by the Mayor, and

17 WHEREAS the Mayor recommends increasing the number of Task Force
18 members from 13 to 15 by adding two additional members representing business
19 and citizen groups, and adding two alternates, to be selected by the Mayor, and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter Section 2.4 and the Rules,
21 Regulations, and Procedures of the City Council, the persons named on
22 Exhibit "A" have been nominated to serve on the Minimum Wage Task Force;
