## BACKGROUND



- City Council Study Session Presentation – July 16, 2019
  - Youth and Young Adult program funding: \$6,843,458
    - Crisis Residential Center: \$1.8M
    - Youth and Young Adult Drop-in/overnight shelter: \$721,060
  - Homelessness Programs funding: \$10,741,971
    - Contracted Services: \$8,404,526
    - Stability Site Operations: \$2,337,445

- City of Tacoma Affordable Housing Action Strategy
  - 2.01 Address Derelict Properties
  - **3.02 & 4.01 Resources for Households in Housing Crisis and Rental Assistance**
- Mayors' Roundtable on Housing Affordability
  - Housing needs
  - Regional approaches
- Mental Health Court
  - In partnership with Tacoma Municipal Court
  - Served 17 individuals in 2019
  - Completed 7 Housing Stability Plans
  - Completed 8 mental health assessments/evaluations
