New Business

Exit Interview – Washington State Auditor

The Washington State Assistant Audit Manager, Joe Simmons, was in attendance to present the Exit Conference for the 2012 Tacoma Employees' Retirement System's audit. The Washington State Auditor's Office Exit Conference report, dated June 13, 2013, was distributed to the Retirement Board in the Board Packet prior to the meeting.

It was noted in the Independent Auditor's Report, dated June 13, 2013, that the Tacoma Employees' Retirement System had received an unmodified audit opinion for calendar year 2012. There were no audit recommendations.

Old Business

Investment Update

Tim Allen reported that there had been a fee revision with Prudential (TERS' emerging market debt manager) that will save the system a few thousand dollars annually.

Tim also mentioned that an existing TERS manager (INTECH) was coming in later in the month to make an informational presentation on low volatility equity strategies. Board members would be invited to attend.

Tim explained to the Board that he would introduce two presenters on commodities investing. The TERS staff and Wilshire had selected these two managers to present to the Board and that there would be a discussion period following the presentation. Tim indicated that it was likely that a formal recommendation would be made at the August Board meeting.

Retirement Director's Report

The Retirement Director's report serves as an addendum to the minutes.

Monica indicated that the July Board meeting did not have agenda topics requiring Board action and suggested that the July Board meeting be canceled. The Board concurred.

Monica reported that the TERS office has been collecting data on deaths in WA from the State Health department to supplement the current death audit process. Three previously unreported deaths have been identified so far. One of the notifications led to the discovery of an overpayment by TERS of approximately \$33K, which staff is working to collect.

Chris Webster, Citizen Representative for the Retired Board since 2003, expressed his happiness in the progress that the Board had made over the years. Mayor Strickland expressed gratitude and appreciation for Chris' contributions and efforts as a Board member.
